

COMPLETION DATE/LIQUIDATED DAMAGES

All work, including placing and watering of sod for parkway restoration and punch list items, shall be completed by <u>May 15, 2025</u>, unless additional time is granted in accordance with Article 108.08 of the Standard Specifications.

Should the Contractor fail to complete all work by this date, the Contractor shall be responsible to remobilize as required to accommodate the Parks event schedule here in attached to the bid documents.

The time required for sod to establish roots and be growing in a live healthy condition in accordance with Article 252.12 of the Standard Specifications along with the removal of temporary erosion control measures shall not be included in the completion date. These items shall be concluded not more than 30 calendar days after the completion date. Should the sod not be in an acceptable condition and the temporary erosion control measures not removed within this time frame, the Contractor shall be liable to pay liquidated damages as stated above.

PEDESTRIAN SIDEWALK CONTROL

The Contractor shall install, maintain, and remove necessary signs and barricades needed to direct pedestrians to usable sidewalks and walkways during the construction in accordance with IDOT Traffic Control Standard Case 701801.

All barricades shall meet the above IDOT standard 70180. At each point of closure, sufficient numbers of barricades shall be used to completely close the sidewalk to pedestrian movement. Where construction activities involve sidewalks on both sides of the street, the work shall be staged so that both sidewalks are not out of service at the same time.

BUTT JOINTS

<u>Description:</u> This work shall apply to the multi-use path project areas which are identified for a hot mix asphalt surface course overlay. The intent of the project pay item is to provide the means for the existing, underlying asphalt surface to accommodate for a 1.5-inch hot mix asphalt surface overlay against adjoining pavement surfaces, such as driveways, sidewalks and end-of-paving limits. The dimensions for the **BUTT JOINTS** shall vary in size, depending on the width of the adjoining pavement surface. The size and location of the **BUTT JOINTS** shall be determined by the Engineer and Contractor, and marked in the field accordingly. The Contractor shall confirm the **BUTT JOINTS** are of suitable dimensions to allow for the hot mix asphalt surface course to be placed at a minimum 1.5 thickness, along the adjacent, undisturbed pavements.



Public Works Parking (Pump Station - 9450 Seton Place Dr)


