Background

The Village of Orland Park recently completed the following public access improvements at Doctor Marsh.

- Two naturalized detention basins
- Riparian vegetation improvements
- Mesic prairie buffer establishment

Other existing site features include the following.

- Creek channel
- Asphalt path

Scope of Work

The Village of Orland Park desires to retain a Contractor to complete additional site work associated with ecological restoration and management, enhancing public health/safety/welfare, and enhancing the visitor experience. The following BASE services, and ALTERNATE services as budget allows, are desired. Please also refer to attached Plan.

BASE Services

 Remove and control the presence of invasive species on site, including invasive forbs, grasses and woody species. Treatment of invasive species will include both mechanical and chemical intervention, and will target invasive species including, but not limited to, common reed, reed canary grass, sweet clover and teasel.

ALTERNATE Services

- 1. Overseeding approximately 1 acre of riparian area.
 - a. Broadcast overseeding into existing vegetation. Seeding of native material shall include installation of a native seed mix containing a non-allelopathic cover crop, not less than 5 pounds per acre of a minimum of three perennial native grasses, and not less than 1.5 pounds per acre of a minimum of 7 perennial native forbs, with a preference for showier pollinator-friendly species (e.g., lobelia, arrow arum, wild bergamot, marsh milkweed, New England Aster, etc.). Post installation management to control weeds and encourage growth of desirable species will be required. Final seed mix shall be subject to review and approval of the Village.
- 2. Overseeding approximately 1 acre of mesic prairie buffer area
 - a. Broadcast overseeding into existing vegetation. Seeding of native material shall include installation of a native seed mix containing a non-allelopathic cover crop, not less than 5 pounds per acre of a minimum of three perennial native grasses, and not less than 1.5 pounds per acre of a minimum of 7 perennial native forbs, with a preference for showier pollinator-friendly species (e.g., yellow coneflower, purple coneflower, wild bergamot, milkweed, showy tick-trefoil, New England Aster, etc.). Post installation management to control weeds and encourage growth of desirable species will be required. Final seed mix shall be subject to review and approval of the Village.
- 3. Reseeding approximately 1 acre of riparian area where previous seeding attempts have not been successful or have failed.
 - a. Light soil preparation (i.e. tilling) shall be performed prior to seeding. Seeding of native material shall include installation of a native seed mix containing a non-allelopathic cover crop, not less than 10 pounds per acre of a minimum of three perennial native grasses, and not less than three pounds per acre of a minimum of 7 perennial native forbs, with a preference for showier pollinator-friendly species (e.g., lobelia, arrow arum, wild bergamot, marsh milkweed, New England Aster, etc.). Post installation management to control weeds and encourage growth of desirable species will be required. Final seed mix shall be subject to review and approval of the Village. Erosion control measures shall be placed wherever erosion may be an issue.

- 4. Reseeding approximately 1 acre of mesic prairie buffer area.
 - a. Light soil preparation (i.e. tilling) shall be performed prior to seeding. Seeding of native material shall include installation of a native seed mix containing a non-allelopathic cover crop, not less than 10 pounds per acre of a minimum of three perennial native grasses, and not less than three pounds per acre of a minimum of 7 perennial native forbs, with a preference for showier pollinator-friendly species (e.g., yellow coneflower, purple coneflower, wild bergamot, milkweed, showy tick-trefoil, New England Aster, etc.). Post installation management to control weeds and encourage growth of desirable species will be required. Final seed mix shall be subject to review and approval of the Village. Erosion control measures shall be placed wherever erosion may be an issue.
- 5. Managing the 108th Avenue embankment area and invasive species control, selective clearing, and native seeding.
 - a. Invasive species control shall focus on control of invasive herbaceous weeds including, but not limited to, common reed, reed canary grass, sweet clover and teasel through herbicide application and cutting.
 - b. Selective clearing shall consist of cutting non-native woody species including but not limited to buckthorn, honeysuckle, and autumn olive; cutting aggressive weedy native woody species including but not limited to buckthorn, honeysuckle; application of herbicide to cut stumps; removal and disposal of cut brush; follow-up cutting and/or herbicide application to address resprouts and new growth after initial cutting.
 - c. Native seeding shall include soil preparation (e.g., light tilling and/or fine grading as necessary); installation of a native seed mix containing a non-allelopathic cover crop, not less than 10 pounds per acre of a minimum of three perennial native grasses, and not less than three pounds per acre of a minimum of 7 perennial native forbs, with a preference for showier pollinator-friendly species (e.g., yellow coneflower, purple coneflower, wild bergamot, milkweed, showy tick-trefoil, New England Aster, etc.); erosion control (e.g., straw erosion control blanket, crimped straw mulch, or hydromulch) on disturbed bare soils (may not be necessary if no-till seeding is utilized); and post installation management to control weeds and encourage growth of desirable species. Final seed mix shall be subject to review and approval of the Village.
