ITEMS FOR SEPARATE ACTION

2012-0195 Village Code Amendment Title 9, Chapter 15 - Recommended Ordinance

Police Chief Timothy McCarthy reported that the Police Department is seeking to amend Title 9, Chapter 15 Section 11 (Administrative Adjudication of Vehicular Standing, Parking and Compliance Violations) of the Village Code so that towing/impoundment of vehicles with three or more unpaid tickets is consistent for residents and non-residents.

Currently, only vehicles owned by Orland Park residents who have three or more unpaid tickets may have their vehicle towed/impounded if located within the geographical boundaries of the Village of Orland Park. This amendment would allow that any vehicle with three or more unpaid parking tickets issued by the Village of Orland Park may be towed/impounded if located within the geographical boundaries of the Village of Orland Park.
