Proposed new ordinance for ground feeding of animals

This ordinance would be placed in Title 6 Chapter 2 – Nuisances

6-2-2-1

6. **Ground Feeding Prohibited**

The ground feeding of birds, cats, squirrels, chipmunks, rats, mice, rabbits, raccoons, opossums, skunks, deer, ducks, geese or any other wild animals is prohibited in order to prevent rodent infestation, disease from feces, and a public nuisance from droppings. Ground feeding is defined as the spreading, casting, laying depositing, or dumping of feed including, but not limited to, birdseed, corn, bread pieces, food scraps or any like or similar substance, on any public or private property in the Village of Orland Park, II. Above-ground hanging bird feeders are allowed as long as all feed is placed in a container or feeder designed for the specific purpose of feeding birds.
