This area is dedicated to fun and exercise activities with your dog. Dogs may run off-leash, under voice control, within the confines of the fenced area. The dog park is a member's only area. - Users of this facility do so at their own risk. The Village of Orland Park is not responsible for any injury or damage caused by any dog in the off leash area.
- The "Dogout" is restricted to members only. In order to obtain a membership proof of vaccinations will be required. Member's identification and dog's tag should be worn and visible at all times.
- Please keep your dog from jumping on other dogs or people.
- Pick up waste and dispose of it in the receptacles provided.
- Owners are responsible for the actions of their dog as well as any injury, damage to property, other dogs or the public.
- Children under 12 years must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older. Children 5 and under are not permitted in the off leash area.
- A handler age 16 or older must be present at all times and is solely responsible for the actions of their dog(s).
- Dogs must be leashed prior to and leaving the park. Owners must carry a leash at all times.
- Collars must be worn at all times. No pincher or spiked collars are permitted, as they are dangerous when playing.
- Keep your dogs in sight and never leave dogs in park unattended.
- No aggressive dogs allowed. Dogs with a known history of, or who exhibit aggressive or dangerous behavior are prohibited. Immediately leash your dog and leave the park if aggressive behavior is observed.
- A limit of two (2) dogs per person allowed at one time. Both dogs must remain in the same run area with their owner.
- Large dogs, 30 pounds and over, are not allowed in the small dog area.
- Dogs in heat are not permitted in the park.
- Puppies must be at least 4 months old to use the park.
- No food of any kind, including dog treats, are allowed within the fenced area.
