VILLAGE OF ORLAND PARK SCADA System Assessment (Contract for Services)

This Contract is made this **25th day of April**, **2008** by and between the Village of Orland Park (hereinafter referred to as the "VILLAGE") and B&W Control Systems Integration (hereinafter referred to as the "CONTRACTOR").

WITNESSETH

In consideration of the promises and covenants made herein by the VILLAGE and the CONTRACTOR (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "PARTIES,") the PARTIES agree as follows:

SECTION 1: THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS: This Contract shall include the following documents (hereinafter referred to as the "CONTRACT DOCUMENTS") however this Contract takes precedence and controls over any contrary provision in any of the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS. The Contract, including the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, expresses the entire agreement between the PARTIES and where it modifies, adds to or deletes provisions in other CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, the Contract's provisions shall prevail. Provisions in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS unmodified by this Contract shall be in full force and effect in their unaltered condition.

SECTION 2: SCOPE OF THE WORK AND PAYMENT: The CONTRACTOR agrees to provide labor, equipment and materials necessary to provide the services as described in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS and further described below:

Test of all SCADA status/alarm inputs; document communications and critical SCADA infrastructure items and provide up-to-date diagram; identify cost effective improvements; obtain PLC Code back-up from all sites. All work to be accomplished as outlined in the proposal dated March 24, 2008

(hereinafter referred to as the "WORK") and the VILLAGE agrees to pay the CONTRACTOR pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Prompt Payment Act (50 ILCS 505/1 et seq.) the following amount for performance of the described services: Nine thousand four hundred forty and No/100 (\$9,440.00) Dollars.

SECTION 3: ASSIGNMENT: CONTRACTOR shall not assign the duties and obligations involved in the performance of the WORK which is the subject matter of this Contract without the written consent of the VILLAGE.

SECTION 4: TERM OF THE CONTRACT: This Contract shall commence on the date of its execution. The WORK shall commence and continue expeditiously for 2 months from that date. This Contract shall terminate upon completion of the WORK or 6 month(s), whichever occurs first, but may be terminated by either of the PARTIES for default upon failure to cure after ten (10) days prior written notice of said default from the aggrieved PARTY. The VILLAGE, for its convenience, may terminate this Contract with thirty (30) days prior written notice.

SECTION 5: INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE: The CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and hold harmless the VILLAGE, its trustees, officers, directors, agents, employees and representatives and assigns, from lawsuits, actions, costs (including attorneys' fees), claims or liability of any character, incurred due to the alleged negligence of the CONTRACTOR, brought because of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person, persons or property on account of any act or omission, neglect or misconduct of said CONTRACTOR, its officers, agents and/or employees arising out of, or in performance of any of the provisions of the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, including any claims or amounts recovered for any infringements of patent, trademark or copyright; or from any claims or amounts arising or recovered under the "Worker's Compensation Act" or any other law, ordinance, order or decree. In connection with any such claims, lawsuits, actions or liabilities, the VILLAGE, its trustees, officers, directors, agents, employees, representatives and their assigns shall have the right to defense counsel of their choice. The CONTRACTOR shall be solely liable for all costs of such defense and for all expenses, fees, judgments, settlements and all other costs arising out of such claims, lawsuits, actions or liabilities.

The Contractor shall not make any settlement or compromise of a lawsuit or claim, or fail to pursue any available avenue of appeal of any adverse judgment, without the approval of the Village and any other indemnified party. The Village or any other indemnified party, in its or their sole discretion, shall have the option of being represented by its or their own counsel. If this option is exercised, then the Contractor shall promptly reimburse the Village or other indemnified party, upon written demand, for any expenses, including but not limited to court costs, reasonable attorneys' and witnesses' fees and other expenses of litigation incurred by the Village or other indemnified party in connection therewith.

Execution of this Contract by the VILLAGE is contingent upon receipt of Insurance Certificates provided by the CONTRACTOR in compliance with the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.

SECTION 6: COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS: CONTRACTOR agrees to comply with all federal, state and local laws, ordinances, statutes, rules and regulations including but not limited to the Illinois Human Rights Act as follows: CONTRACTOR hereby agrees that this contract shall be performed in compliance with all requirements of the Illinois Human Rights Act, 775 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and that the CONTRACTOR and its subcontractors shall not engage in any prohibited form of discrimination in employment as defined in that Act and shall maintain a sexual harassment policy as the Act requires. The CONTRACTOR shall maintain, and require that its subcontractors maintain, policies of equal employment opportunity which shall prohibit discrimination against any

SECTION 8: STANDARD OF SERVICE: Services shall be rendered to the highest professional standards to meet or exceed those standards met by others providing the same or similar services in the Chicagoland area. Dear John:

Now that the Village's Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) server has been recently replaced and operating well, we have identified with Village staff the need to verify the connectivity/operation of all of the SCADA system equipment and alarms, and identify a plan for systematically making improvements to the remaining SCADA infrastructure. This project would involve visiting each SCADA site to accomplish three primary tasks:

- Test all of the SCADA system status/alarm inputs to ensure they are still in working order and document items which do not function properly and need further investigation.
- Document communications and critical SCADA infrastructure items and provide the Village with an up-to-date diagram that documents the SCADA network accurately. This document should be a "living document" that gets updated each time a change is made to the SCADA system.
- Identify and plan for cost-effective improvements to the system to improve reliability, improve performance, and improve flexibility and operator utilization of the system.

Following is our recommended Scope of Services to provide the Village with a practical, compressive look at the current hardware and software needs for the Village's SCADA system.



Base Scope of Services

Status/Alarm System Test

- Test all SCADA data points (status and alarm signals), verity analog signals that can be tested on-site, and document radio signal strength to the master location at the following sites:
 - Public Works (no direct I/O, just SCADA computers and radio).
 - Police Station.
 - Seven (7) Water Towers.
 - Thirteen (13) Lift Stations.
 - Booster Pump Stations.
 - · Main Pump Station.

Equipment Inventory

- Compile and provide a list of all SCADA computer hardware, including communication cards required to connect to all Village SCADA/Programmable Logic Controller (PLC) devices.
- Compile and provide a list of all SCADA (and related) computer software products and versions. This list can be used by the Village in the future to assess upgrades, modifications, and machine rebuilds.

System Diagram

Create a Microsoft[®] Visio[™] drawing (object-style diagram) of all SCADA equipment and communication types, including SCADA telemetry as well as connection to the Village LAN/WAN. Provide the Village with an electronic version of the resulting diagram as an industry-standard PDF format, as well as in the native Visio format.

Disaster Recovery Plan

- Review the current procedures for backups, both disaster-related, as well as general data backup and restoration procedures.
- Make recommendations to cover future implementations of SCADA equipment and appropriate best-practices for a safe and secure SCADA system operation.

Report

 Provide a letter report outlining recommendations for SCADA system improvements that will benefit the Village in the long term. The report will



include a summary of the existing system, evaluation, and recommendations including budget costs and priority for the improvements.

Option 1 Scope - PLC Code Backup

If the Village chooses, BWCSI will visit all of the SCADA system sites and upload a copy of the PLC programs from each PLC and make backups of the SCADA software. Two (2) copies of all programs will be provided to the Village on a CD. This backup CD will *not contain* historical data or commented code (unless it is made available to BWCSI), but merely the most critical information needed to rebuild any portion of the SCADA system in the event of a specific PLC or SCADA server failure.

Fee

Our fee for the above Base Scope of Services is a lump sum of \$7,640.

Our fee for the Option 1 Scope of Services is an additional lump sum of \$1,800.

Fees are valid for 90 days from the date of this proposal

STANDARD TERMS & CONDITIONS

The submitted proposal and these Standard Terms & Conditions constitute and are herein referred to as the Agreement.

B&W Control Systems Integration, LLC is herein referred to as BWCSI, and the party with whom BWCSI is entering into this Agreement

with is herein referred to as OWNER.

BWCSI may submit requests for periodic progress payments for services rendered. Payments shall be due and owing by the OWNER 3 upon receipt of BWCSI's invoice for services. Payments to BWCSI after (60) consecutive calendar days from the date of BWCSI's invoice for services shall include an additional late payment charge computed at an annual rate of twelve percent (12%) from date of BWCSI's invoice; and BWCSI may, after giving seven (7) days written notice to the OWNER, suspend services under this Agreement until BWCSI has been paid in full all amounts due for services, expenses, and late payment charges.

This Agreement may be terminated, in whole or in part, by either party if the other party substantially fails to fulfill its obligations under this Agreement through no fault of the terminating party; or the OWNER may terminate this Agreement, in whole or in part, for its convenience. However, no such termination may be effected unless the terminating party gives the other party: (1) not less than ten (10) calendar days written notice by certified mail of intent to terminate, and (2) an opportunity for a meeting with the terminating party before termination. If this Agreement is terminated by either party, BWCSI shall be paid for services performed to the effective date of termination, including reimbursable expenses. In the event of contract termination, the OWNER shall receive reproducible copies of Drawings, Custom

reimbursable expenses. In the event of contract termination, the OWNER shall receive reproducible copies of Drawings, Custom Developed Applications and other documents completed by BWCSI.

BWCSI agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the OWNER and each of its officers, agents and employees from any and all liability claims, losses, or damages, to the extent that that such claims, losses, or damages are caused by BWCSI's negligence in the performance of the services under this Agreement, but not including liability that may be due to the sole negligence of the OWNER or other consultants, contractors or subcontractors working for the OWNER, or their officers, agents and employees. In the event claims, losses, or damages are caused by the joint or concurrent negligence of BWCSI and the OWNER they shall be borne by each party in proportion to its negligence.

The OWNER acknowledges that BWCSI is a Limited Liability Company and not a Professional Service Corporation, and further acknowledges that the corporate entity, as the party to this contract, expressly avoids contracting for individual responsibility of its officers,

directors, or employees

The OWNER and BWCSI agree that any claim made by either party arising out of any act of the other party, or any officer, director, or employee of the other party in the execution or performance of the Agreement, shall be made solely against the other party and not

individually or jointly against such officer, director, or employees.

For the duration of the project, BWCSI shall procure and maintain insurance for protection from claims under worker's compensation acts, For the duration of the project, BWCSI shall procure and maintain insurance for protection from claims under worker's compensation act claims for damages because of bodily injury including personal injury, sickness or disease or death of any and all employees or of any person other than such employees, and from claims or damages because of injury to or destruction of property including loss of use resulting therefrom, alleged to arise from BWCSI's negligence in the performance of services under this Agreement. The OWNER shall be named as an additional insured on BWCSI's general liability insurance policy. The limits of liability for the insurance required by this Subsection are as follows:

That, if it hires additional employees in order to perform this Agreement, or any portion hereof, it will determine the availability (in accordance with the Department's Rules and Regulations for Public Contracts) of minorities and women in the area(s) from which it may reasonably recruit and it will hire for each job classification for which employees are hired in such a way that minorities and women are not underutilized.
- **C.** That, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by it or on its behalf, it will state that all applicants will be afforded equal opportunity without discrimination because of race, color, religion, sex, marital status, national origin or ancestry, age, or physical or mental handicap unrelated to ability, or an unfavorable discharge from military service.
- **D.** That it will send to each labor organization or representative of workers with which it has or is bound by a collective bargaining or other agreement or understanding, a notice advising such labor organization or representative of the Vendor's obligations under the Illinois Human Rights Act and Department's Rules and Regulations for Public Contract.
- E. That it will submit reports as required by the Department's Rules and

Regulations for Public Contracts, furnish all relevant information as may from time to time be requested by the Department or the contracting agency, and in all respects comply with the Illinois Human Rights Act and Department's Rules and Regulations for Public Contracts.

- **F.** That it will permit access to all relevant books, records, accounts and work sites by personnel of the contracting agency and Department for purposes of investigation to ascertain compliance with the Illinois Human Rights Act and Department's Rules and Regulations for Public Contracts.
- **G.** That it will include verbatim or by reference the provisions of this Equal Employment Opportunity Clause in every subcontract it awards under which any portion of this Agreement obligations are undertaken or assumed, so that such provisions will be binding upon such subcontractor. In the same manner as the other provisions of this Agreement, the Vendor will be liable for compliance with applicable provisions of this clause by such subcontractors; and further it will promptly notify the contracting agency and the Department in the event any subcontractor fails or refuses to comply therewith. In addition, the Vendor will not utilize any subcontractor declared by the Illinois Human Rights Department to be ineligible for contracts or subcontracts with the State of Illinois or any of its political subdivisions or municipal corporations.

Section III. For the purposes of subsection G of Section II, "subcontract" means any agreement, arrangement or understanding, written or otherwise, between the Vendor and any person under which any portion of the Vendor's obligations under one or more public contracts is performed, undertaken or assumed; the term "subcontract", however, shall not include any agreement, arrangement or understanding in which the parties stand in the relationship of an employer and an employee, or between a Vendor or other organization and its customers.
