RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE ILLINOIS TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM FOR PROPOSED MULTI-PURPOSE PATHS ON 159<sup>TH</sup> STREET, 108<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE AND 104<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the *President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Orland Park, Cook and Will Counties*, Illinois, as follows:

## Section 1

The Village Board authorizes the Village Manager, or his designee, to submit a grant proposal to the Illinois Transportation Enhancement Program (ITEP) for multi-purpose paths on 159<sup>th</sup> Street (between Ravinia Avenue and 80<sup>th</sup> Avenue), 108<sup>th</sup> Avenue (between 153<sup>rd</sup> Street and Jillian Road) and 104<sup>th</sup> Avenue (between 159<sup>th</sup> Street and 163<sup>rd</sup> Street). The total estimated cost for each project is \$4,143,850 for the 159<sup>th</sup> Street path, \$292,215 for the 108<sup>th</sup> Avenue path, and \$2,265,645 for the 104<sup>th</sup> Avenue path per the applications prepared by the Village's engineering consultant, Christopher B. Burke Engineering Ltd. Said proposed paths are not being approved for funding at this time and would be constructed upon the receipt of grant funding assistance. The local cost share for a project would be budgeted upon award.

## Section 2

This resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
