

You should make the age cut off longer, have the older kids help, the one in Mokena has the X generation so it goes summer after 8th grade. Or make junior counselors.

Have it be a daily rate versus sessions. That way if parents only need MTF they can only pay for that. offer flexibility on what days you want. Such as monday, tuesday and thursday instead of M. W & F.

The restrictions at the pool and how the children are leveled seems very unrealistic. My child was asked to swim the complete length of the pool in deep water just to be able to go in the 4 foot area and go on the tube slide and blue and green slide. He was very limited to where he was able to go.

- He went on all the slides the whole summer every time we went to the pool as a family with the exception of the high dive. He is a decent swimmer and takes lessons. I understand the safety concerns and how dangerous pools can be for some children. However, there should be leveled tests appropriate for each age group and not just a flat test to see if a child can jump in the deep end and swim the length of the pool to be able to venture out of the baby areas of the pool.
 - I am a little concerned about the quantity of campers versus the number of counselors on pool days.
- 9. I feel like anyone could grab a child and walk out of the pool as it has to be virtually impossible for one person to keep track of 10 children when their all running around everywhere.

I wish the program would consider adding time leading up to the start of school. I am sure i am not the only parent that has this problem. There is a 2-3 week period where no day camp is offered and kids are not in school. It is hard to find care for my son for that time frame.

- The trip to 7-11 was not a favorite for my son--he does not like slushies and would have preferred a regular drink--maybe that could be an option for next year---sounds silly I know, but a big deal if you are 9.
