ORLAND PARK RESIDENTIAL EXTERIOR INSULATION AND RE-SIDING PROGRAM

AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT 2009

Introduction

The Residential Exterior Insulation and Re-Siding Program (REIRS) is a voluntary sub-grant program funded by the US Department of Energy's Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). REIRS is designed to assist residents in eligible subdivisions obtain financial assistance to plan for and implement energy efficiency and conservation retro-fits to the exterior of their homes.

This program is open to all residents/ residential property owners in the Cameno Re'al, Fairway Estates, Fernway, Gee's Addition and Orland Hills Gardens subdivisions.

Residents/ residential property owners must install at least \$500 worth of energy efficiency and conservation improvements in order to qualify for this grant program. Eligible improvements will be funded up to 50% of the total cost of the project, up to a maximum \$5,000, whichever is less. The Village of Orland Park Development Services Department reserves the right to waive this and any other program parameter in the interest of meeting ARRA goals and objectives.

REIRS Funding

Funding is limited to \$50,000 allocated by EECBG. The program is first-come, first serve. If more applications are received than funding levels will allow, the applications will be rejected. ARRA requires EECBG funds to be completely obligated in 18 months from the date of approval. The Village reserves the right to requisition REIRS dollars to fully obligate all unused funds for a public purpose.

REIRS Concept Meeting, Review Process, Smart Ideas for Your Home and the Energy Star Pledge

A resident or residential property owner seeking REIRS assistance must first meet with the Development Services Department to discuss the proposed project. The petitioner must then submit a complete application to the Department. Following an internal review, the application will appear at the next available meeting of the Parks, Recreation and Environmental Initiatives Committee of Trustees. The Committee will review the project and make a recommendation to the Village Board for a final decision.

Building permits are required for all proposed work. Simultaneous application is encouraged. Enrollment to ComEd's <u>Smart Ideas for Your Home's</u> (SIYH) Central Air Conditioning Efficiency Services program or Central Air Conditioning Cycling program is required prior to receiving REIRS assistance. Residents or residential property owners are also required to take the <u>US EPA's Energy Star Pledge</u> prior to receiving funding assistance.

REIRS Rules

The following rules apply to the Residential Exterior Insulation and Re-Siding Program:

- Variances and modification from the Land Development Code or Village Code are not permitted. Projects will be recommended for denial if a variance or modification is requested.
- Only structurally sound buildings will be considered for this grant program.
- REIRS applications must include a copy of a submitted ComEd SIYH enrollment form to qualify for assistance.
- Applicable ARRA reporting and other requirements must be met (e.g. Davis-Bacon wages, copies of all
 invoices and orders, work schedules, specification sheets etc. must be submitted during the project).

REIRS improvements are bound by the Residential Exterior Insulation and Re-Siding Program Agreement (REIRSA). All project costs are to be borne by the applicant in full with reimbursement pending from the Village only after work is completed per the approved plan and all conditions are met as verified by the Village's inspection per the signed agreement. At such time, funds will be dispersed in the form of a check paid out to the applicant upon submittal and verification of the receipts for the specified work. The Village reserves the right to disburse ARRA funds in accordance with ARRA regulations to meet program objectives in a timely manner. Projects will have a limited time (up to 12 months) following the obligation of funds and notice to proceed to complete the project. Failure to complete the project by February 2012 may result in losing financial assistance.

ComEd's Smart Ideas for Your Home: Air Condition Cycling and Efficiency

REIRS applications must include a copy of a completed and submitted <u>Smart Ideas for Your Home</u> enrollment form to either the Central Air Conditioning Cycling Program or the Central Air Conditioning Efficiency Services program prior to receiving funding. With the <u>Central AC Cycling Program</u>, applicants are guaranteed \$20-\$40 incentive from ComEd for cycling compressor units during the summer months. Improved insulation efficiency as a result of this program will improve conditioned air retention.

Eligible Projects and Assistance

All REIRS assisted improvements must be related to the insulation systems of a home and immediately operational and functional upon implementation. Eligible improvements must be permanent features (with exception to lights) to the house and cannot be removed or moved to another location without authorization from the Village of Orland Park Development Services Department. Costs associated with demolition are not eligible for reimbursement.

<u>Eligible Insulation and Siding Improvements</u> – <u>Energy Star Air Seal and Insulate</u>

- Eligible projects shall strip old siding systems from the house and install house-wrap (i.e. Tyvek etc.) as the first layer.
- New insulated siding, or separate foam board and siding construction, is permissible.
- Eligible products for new insulated siding or otherwise must be Energy Star rated and have an R-value of 3 or better.
- Other materials (e.g. masonry construction etc.) must obtain approval from the Development Services Department and demonstrate an equivalent or better Energy Star rating and R-value.
- A goal of this program is to achieve a combined total R-value of 5 or better for the exterior of building walls with insulation retro-fits. (This does not include or measure the interior R-value).
- Costs associated with air leak sealing may be covered by this program provided an insulated siding project is proposed.

Eligible Window and Door Improvements - Energy Star Windows, Doors and Skylights

- Eligible projects shall install Energy Star qualified windows and doors under the new Jan. 4, 2010 US EPA criteria.
- Eligible windows shall be Energy Star rated and Low-E or Argon Gas/ double pane.
- Eligible doors shall be Energy Star rated.

Eligible Lighting Improvements – Energy Star Lighting

- Eligible lighting improvements shall be limited to exterior façade-mounted lights only.
- Exterior facade-mounted lights shall be either Energy Star CFL or LED.
- Lighting improvements and Energy Star rated lighting sensors may be covered by the program provided an insulated siding project is proposed.

Ineligible Projects and Improvements

- Exterior Insulation and Finishing Systems (EIFS) materials are not permitted;
- Building improvements unrelated to insulation and re-siding:

- Improvements completed prior to notification of approval of the grant application;
- Painting;
