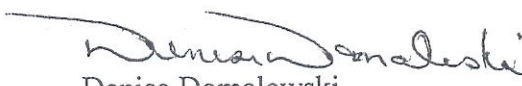
This notification is to inform you that the Village of Orland Park has received the Notice to Proceed from Cook County for work to commence on the above stated project per CDBG Grant #09-023.
