Dear Mr. Mazza,

F.H. Paschen has visited the project site with the Village of Orland Park and agreed to the following scope of work. We are pleased to present the following scope of work for your review. Pricing is based on the drawing “Village of Orland Park CPAC Modernization Project - Phase 1” dated 8/5/25.

Scope of Work

- Remove and replace gas regulators on hot water heaters and gas serving concession.
- Perform all underground boring to install 3” natural gas piping.
- Remove and replace overhead gas piping per USK2.
- Furnish and install new precast ComEd transformer pad and empty raceway per USK-3
- Install 16’ of owner furnished fence.
- Perform landscape restoration in pad and boring areas.

The budgeted cost to furnish and install the above referenced work is **One Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Dollars, \$137,550.00**

- This proposal **excludes** permit fees.
- This proposal **includes** using the OMNIA Cooperative Agreement and includes the associated fees.
- This proposal **excludes** any material cost increases or schedule impacts due to any tariffs.
- This proposal **excludes** the removal and disposal of any hazardous material.
- This proposal **excludes** any unforeseen conditions that may arise.
- This proposal **excludes** any overtime or premium time, proposal is based on normal work hours.
- This proposal **excludes** any payment and performance bonds.
- This proposal **excludes** utility fees, concrete cutting or removal, heat tracing, HEPA/containment.
- This proposal **excludes** sales tax.
- This proposal **excludes** any site utilities work.
- This proposal **excludes** any carpentry work.
- This proposal **excludes** any plumbing, or fire suppression work.
- This proposal **excludes** any repair, replacement, or re-location of piping underground.
- This proposal **excludes** any design, engineering, or associated drawings.



- This proposal ***excludes*** any furniture or equipment movement.
- This proposal includes only the following items described in the above scope.
