Dear Mr. Mazza,

F.H. Paschen has visited the project site with the Village of Orland Park and agreed to the following scope of work. We are pleased to present the following scope of work for your review. Pricing is based on the drawing "Village of Orland Park CPAC Modernization Project - Phase 1" dated 8/5/25.

Scope of Work

- Remove and replace gas regulators on hot water heaters and gas serving concession.
- Perform all underground boring to install 3" natural gas piping.
- Remove and replace overhead gas piping per USK2.
- Furnish and install new precast ComEd transformer pad and empty raceway per USK-3
- Install 16' of owner furnished fence.
- Perform landscape restoration in pad and boring areas.

The budgeted cost to furnish and install the above referenced work is **One Hundred Thirty-Seven Thousand Five Hundred Fifty Dollars**, \$137,550.00





