Whereas, George Mitchell is active in Kiwanis Bingo providing approximately \$125,000 a year to the community and local charities while his wife Nancy helped raise over \$1.2 million for the McCord Gallery and Cultural Center addition in Palos Park; and

*Whereas*, Mitchell's Flowers provided their services to both Marshall Fields and Carson's for their Grand Openings at Orland Square; and

Whereas, George and Dan are both members of the American Institute of Floral Design while George, Dave and Nancy are all members of the American Academy of Floriculture and were honored with the opportunity to work with other talented florists throughout the country for the Inaugural Balls for three presidents; President George Bush Sr., President Bill Clinton and President George Bush Jr. and various Rose Bowl Parade floats.
