**RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE VILLAGE OF ORLAND PARK
TO VACATE A PORTION OF RAVINIA AVENUE**

WHEREAS, the Township deems it necessary and desirable to expand its parking lot, located at 14807 S. Ravinia Avenue, north of the existing driveway; and

WHEREAS, expansion of the parking lot will require the vacation by the Village of Orland Park of a portion of dedicated but unimproved Ravinia Avenue right-of-way, consisting of approximately 5,445 square feet; and

WHEREAS, the Township has caused to be prepared a proposed Plat of Vacation, a true and correct copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as EXHIBIT "A";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Supervisor and Board of Trustees of Orland Township, Cook County, Illinois as follows:

SECTION 1:

It is hereby requested that the corporate authorities of the Village of Orland Park, Cook and Will Counties, Illinois, vacate that portion of Ravinia Avenue, a Village street/roadway, legally described as follows:

THAT PORTION OF RAVINIA AVENUE 33 FEET WEST OF LOT 2 OF OWNER'S SUBDIVISION OF THE SOUTH 165 FEET OF THE NORTH 1/2 OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE EAST 1/2 OF THE SOUTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 9, TOWNSHIP 36 NORTH, RANGE 12 EAST OF THE THIRD PRINCIPAL MERIDIAN IN COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, PER DOCUMENT NUMBER 1962093 RECORDED JANUARY 27, 1961,

in accordance with Section 11-91-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-91-1) and Section 1, et seq., of the Illinois Plat Act (765 ILCS 205/1, et seq.).

SECTION 2:

All costs and fees incurred by the corporate authorities of the Village of Orland Park in accomplishing the vacation of that portion of Ravinia Avenue as herein described, including the preparation and recording of the necessary Village ordinance and Plat of Vacation (EXHIBIT "A") shall be reimbursed by the Township.

SECTION 3:

This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption and approval as provided by law.




