This notification is to inform you that on April 6, 2009, the Village of Orland Park Board of Trustees approved awarding TruGreen, Inc. of Crestwood the contract in accordance with the bid you submitted dated March 18, 2009, for Fertilization and Broadleaf Weed Control 2009-2011 for a total amount of Sixty Seven Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-Seven No/100 (\$67,467.00) Dollars per year for each of the three years of the contract. The total amount is subject to change due to sites being added or removed at the Village's discretion.

(Contract for Services)

This Contract is made this **20th day of April, 2009** by and between The Village of Orland Park (hereinafter referred to as the "VILLAGE") and Trugreen, Inc. of Crestwood, IL (hereinafter referred to as the "CONTRACTOR").

WITNESSETH

In consideration of the promises and covenants made herein by the VILLAGE and the CONTRACTOR (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "PARTIES"), the PARTIES agree as follows:

SECTION 1: THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS: This Contract shall include the following documents (hereinafter referred to as the "CONTRACT DOCUMENTS") however this Contract takes precedence and controls over any contrary provision in any of the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS. The Contract, including the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, expresses the entire agreement between the PARTIES and where it modifies, adds to or deletes provisions in other CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, the Contract's provisions shall prevail. Provisions in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS unmodified by this Contract shall be in full force and effect in their unaltered condition.

- All Certifications required by the Village
- Certificates of insurance

SECTION 2: SCOPE OF THE WORK AND PAYMENT: The CONTRACTOR agrees to provide labor, equipment and materials necessary to provide the services as described in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS and further described below:

Fertilization and Broadleaf Weed Control Applications on select Village property sites in accordance to Classification and Village Schedule as defined in the Classification Sheets.

Orland Park Program 2009/2010/2011

Classification II Properties –

May – 25-0-5 50% PCU with Escalade 3pts / acre

All fertilizer rates are 0.75 lb / N / 1000

Areas such as parking islands and around buildings must be applied by hand.

Late October – 25-0-5 50% PCU with Escalade 3pts / acre

All fertilizer rates are 0.75 lb / N / 1000

Areas such as parking islands and around buildings must be applied by hand.

Classification IV Properties –

Late May Weed Control Only – Escalade 3pts / acre

No fertilizers should be applied within 15 feet of any water's edge.

Areas such as parking islands and around buildings must be applied by hand.

Organic Options

Natural based blended product substitute for 25-0-5 50% PCU 18-0-5

All Natural fertilizer – substitute for 25-0-5 50 % PCU 10-2-6

(hereinafter referred to as the “WORK”) and the VILLAGE agrees to pay the CONTRACTOR pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Prompt Payment Act (50 ILCS 505/1 *et seq.*) the following amount for performance of the described services:

The Contractor shall be paid only for each location treated in accordance with the bid prices submitted as listed on the attached “Classification Schedules,” not to exceed the following amount per year (with the exception of site additions):

Classification II (Parks) - Fifty Six Thousand Seven Hundred Twenty-Eight and No/100 (\$56,728.00) Dollars

Classification IV (Parks) - Two Thousand Six Hundred Sixty-Three and No/100 (\$2,663.00) Dollars

Classification IV (Public Works) - Eight Thousand Seventy-Six and No/100 (\$8,076.00) Dollars

The Village may, at its discretion, select individual sites not to be treated or treated on a different schedule. The Village may also add sites not currently listed. In the event of site additions throughout the course of the contract:

The CONTRACTOR will perform the work for Classification II properties at Eighty and No/100 (\$80.00) Dollars per acre with no minimum for sites added that are less than one acre.

The CONTRACTOR will perform the work for Classification IV (Parks) properties at Thirty-Five and No/100 (\$35.00) Dollars per acre with no minimum for sites added that are less than one acre.

The CONTRACTOR will perform the work for Classification IV (Public Works)) properties at Fifty

and No/100 (\$50.00) Dollars per acre with no minimum for sites added that are less than one acre.

The fees stated above will remain the same for each year of the three year term of the contract, unless 30 days written notice is given prior to the annual anniversary date of the executed contract that the Village does not wish to renew the contract.

In addition, the CONTRACTOR agrees to comply with the following conditions:

1. Written notification must be made on the "Broadleaf Completion Report" to the Director of Parks (fax PARKS 708-403-6289) and Director of Public Works (fax PUBLIC WORKS 708-403-8798) within 48 hours prior to and immediately after any fertilizer or herbicide application. Notification details should include location, site ID, date, and approximate time areas will be treated.
2. All and or any regulations regarding the spraying and fertilization on school property must comply with all State, School District and local laws. MUST call School District prior to treatment to make sure they are ready for your service.
3. All vehicles or equipment shall be identified by the contractor's name for purpose of identification.
4. Products used must be registered and approved by the USEPA and IL. Dept. of Ag. For use on ornamental lawns. All applicable M.S.D.S. sheets must be forwarded to the Purchasing Department, 14700 Ravinia Avenue, Orland Park, IL 60462.
5. All operators and applicators must be certified and licensed with the State of Illinois. Copies of all applicator's and operator's licenses must be provided to the Village prior to the start of the first treatment.
6. Contractor is to bill each department separately (Classification II & Classification IV – Recreation and Parks Department; Classification IV – Public Works Department).
7. Invoices must include name and address of contractor, purchase order number, an itemized listing of work performed, and the date of completion during the billing period.
8. Bill the Village Departments monthly for services rendered no later than the 10th of the month following an application period.

SECTION 3: ASSIGNMENT: CONTRACTOR shall not assign the duties and obligations involved in the performance of the WORK which is the subject matter of this Contract without the written consent of the VILLAGE.

SECTION 4: TERM OF THE CONTRACT: This Contract shall commence on the date of its execution. The WORK shall commence upon a receipt of a Notice to Proceed and continue expeditiously for the years 2009, 2010 and 2011, unless the Village notifies the CONTRACTOR, in writing, thirty (30) days prior to the annual anniversary date of the executed contract, that it does not

wish to renew the contract. The contractor shall work between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., except Saturday or Sundays and holidays recognized by the Village. This Contract shall terminate upon completion of the WORK or December 31, 2011, whichever occurs first, but may be terminated by either of the PARTIES for default upon failure to cure after ten (10) days prior written notice of said default from the aggrieved PARTY. The VILLAGE, for its convenience, may terminate this Contract with thirty (30) days prior written notice.

SECTION 5: INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE: The CONTRACTOR shall indemnify and hold harmless the VILLAGE, its trustees, officers, directors, agents, employees and representatives and assigns, from lawsuits, actions, costs (including attorneys' fees), claims or liability of any character, incurred due to the alleged negligence of the CONTRACTOR, brought because of any injuries or damages received or sustained by any person, persons or property on account of any act or omission, neglect or misconduct of said CONTRACTOR, its officers, agents and/or employees arising out of, or in performance of any of the provisions of the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, including any claims or amounts recovered for any infringements of patent, trademark or copyright; or from any claims or amounts arising or recovered under the "Worker's Compensation Act" or any other law, ordinance, order or decree. In connection with any such claims, lawsuits, actions or liabilities, the VILLAGE, its trustees, officers, directors, agents, employees, representatives and their assigns shall have the right to defense counsel of their choice. The CONTRACTOR shall be solely liable for all costs of such defense and for all expenses, fees, judgments, settlements and all other costs arising out of such claims, lawsuits, actions or liabilities.

The Contractor shall not make any settlement or compromise of a lawsuit or claim, or fail to pursue any available avenue of appeal of any adverse judgment, without the approval of the Village and any other indemnified party. The Village or any other indemnified party, in its or their sole discretion, shall have the option of being represented by its or their own counsel. If this option is exercised, then the Contractor shall promptly reimburse the Village or other indemnified party, upon written demand, for any expenses, including but not limited to court costs, reasonable attorneys' and witnesses' fees and other expenses of litigation incurred by the Village or other indemnified party in connection therewith.

The indemnification obligation under this paragraph shall not be limited in any way by any limitations on the amount or type of damages, compensation or benefits payable by or for the benefit of Subcontractor or any indemnities under any Worker's Compensation Act, Occupational Disease Act, Disability Benefits Act, or any other employee benefits act. The Subcontractor further agrees to waive any and all liability limitations based upon the Worker's Compensation Act court interpretations or otherwise.

Execution of this Contract by the VILLAGE is contingent upon receipt of Insurance Certificates provided by the CONTRACTOR in compliance with the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.

SECTION 6: COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS: CONTRACTOR agrees to comply with all federal, state and local laws, ordinances, statutes, rules and regulations including but not limited to

the Illinois Human Rights Act as follows: CONTRACTOR hereby agrees that this contract shall be performed in compliance with all requirements of the Illinois Human Rights Act, 775 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and that the CONTRACTOR and its subcontractors shall not engage in any prohibited form of discrimination in employment as defined in that Act and shall maintain a sexual harassment policy as the Act requires. The CONTRACTOR shall maintain, and require that its subcontractors maintain, policies of equal employment opportunity which shall prohibit discrimination against any employee or applicant for employment on the basis of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, ancestry, citizenship status, age, marital status, physical or mental disability unrelated to the individual's ability to perform the essential functions of the job, association with a person with a disability, or unfavorable discharge from military service. CONTRACTOR and all subcontractors shall comply with all requirements of the Act and of the Rules of the Illinois Department of Human Rights with regard to posting information on employees' rights under the Act. CONTRACTOR and all subcontractors shall place appropriate statements identifying their companies as equal opportunity employers in all advertisements for workers to be employed in work to be performed under this contract.

The CONTRACTOR shall obtain all necessary local and state licenses and/or permits that may be required for performance of the WORK and provide those licenses to the VILLAGE prior to commencement of the WORK.

SECTION 7: NOTICE: Where notice is required by the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS it shall be considered received if it is delivered in person, sent by registered United States mail, return receipt requested, delivered by messenger or mail service with a signed receipt, sent by facsimile or e-mail with an acknowledgment of receipt, to the following:

SECTION 8: STANDARD OF SERVICE: Services shall be rendered to the highest professional standards to meet or exceed those standards met by others providing the same or similar services in the Chicagoland area. Sufficient competent personnel shall be provided who with supervision shall complete the services required within the time allowed for performance. The CONTRACTOR'S personnel shall, at all times present a neat appearance and shall be trained to handle all contact with Village residents or Village employees in a respectful manner. At the request

of the Village Manager or a designee, the CONTRACTOR shall replace any incompetent, abusive or disorderly person in its employ.

SECTION 9: PAYMENTS TO OTHER PARTIES: The CONTRACTOR shall not obligate the VILLAGE to make payments to third parties or make promises or representations to third parties on behalf of the VILLAGE without prior written approval of the Village Manager or a designee.



In the event of the Contractor's noncompliance with any provision of this Equal Employment Opportunity Clause, the Illinois Human Right Act, or the Rules and Regulations for Public Contracts of the Department of Human Rights (hereinafter referred to as the Department) the Contractor may be declared non-responsible and therefore ineligible for future contracts or subcontracts with the State of Illinois or any of its political subdivisions or municipal corporations, and this agreement may be canceled or avoided in whole or in part, and such other sanctions or penalties may be imposed or remedies involved as provided by statute or regulation.

- D. That it will send to each labor organization or representative of workers with which it has or is bound by a collective bargaining or other agreement or understanding, a notice advising such labor organization or representative of the Contractor's obligations under the Illinois Human Rights Act and Department's Rules and Regulations for Public Contract.
- E. That it will submit reports as required by the Department's Rules and Regulations for Public Contracts, furnish all relevant information as may from time to time be requested by the Department or the contracting agency, and in all respects comply with the Illinois Human Rights Act and Department's Rules and Regulations for Public Contracts.
- F. That it will permit access to all relevant books, records, accounts and work sites by

personnel of the contracting agency and Department for purposes of investigation to ascertain compliance with the Illinois Human Rights Act and Department's Rules and Regulations for Public Contracts.

G. That it will include verbatim or by reference the provisions of this Equal Employment Opportunity Clause in every subcontract it awards under which any portion of this Agreement obligations are undertaken or assumed, so that such provisions will be binding upon such subcontractor. In the same manner as the other provisions of this Agreement, the Contractor will be liable for compliance with applicable provisions of this clause by such subcontractors; and further it will promptly notify the contracting agency and the Department in the event any subcontractor fails or refuses to comply therewith. In addition, the Contractor will not utilize any subcontractor declared by the Illinois Human Rights Department to be ineligible for contracts or subcontracts with the State of Illinois or any of its political subdivisions or municipal corporations.

Section III. For the purposes of subsection G of Section II, "subcontract" means any agreement, arrangement or understanding, written or otherwise, between the Contractor and any person under which any portion of the Contractor's obligations under one or more public contracts is performed, undertaken or assumed; the term "subcontract", however, shall not include any agreement, arrangement or understanding in which the parties stand in the relationship of an employer and an employee, or between a Contractor or other organization and its customers.
