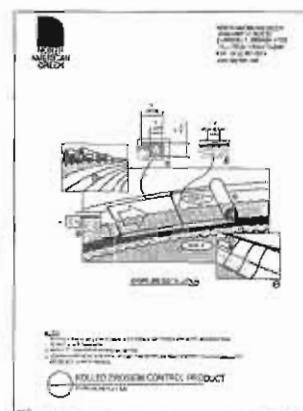
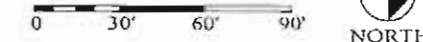

HERBICIDE PROTECTION DETAIL

- PLANT LIST SHOULD SHOW IF THE PLANT SPECIES ARE FOR CONSERVATIVE SOIL. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR PROVIDING AND INSTALLING ALL MATERIALS SHOWN ON THE PLAN AND SHOULD NOT RELY ON THE PLANT SPECIFIER FOR DETERMINING QUALITIES.
- ALL PLANT MATERIALS SHALL BE NURSERY GROWN STOCK AND SHALL BE SHIPPED FROM ANY AREA WITHIN THE UNITED STATES. PLANT STOCK SHALL BE FREE OF DISEASE, INJURY, AND DEFECTS. PROPOSED LEADERS, PINK AMARANTH, BANGALUA, INJURY DAMAGE, ETC. ARE NOT ACCEPTABLE AND MUST BE REJECTED. SEEDS WITH MOLDY LEADERS MUST BE REJECTED. UNLESS STATED OTHERWISE, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE QUALITY OF THE PLANT STOCK.
- ALL PLANTING OPERATIONS SHALL BE COMPLETED IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARD LANDSCAPE INSTALLATION PRACTICES. THIS MAY INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO: PREPARING PLANTING BEDS AND FILL IN PREPARATION, PLANTING AND MULCHING, STAKING AND OUTLINE MARKING, PROTECTING PLANTED AREAS, PLANTING AND ADJUSTING WATERING AND IRRIGATION EQUIPMENT, CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES.
- ALL PLANT MATERIALS MUST BE INSPECTED AND APPROVED BY THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT PRIOR TO INSTALLATION. ANY MATERIALS INSTALLED WITHOUT APPROVAL MAY BE REJECTED.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SUBMIT PLANT MATERIALS FOR A PERIOD IF ONE YEAR FROM DATE OF ACCEPTANCE BY FINCH. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN PROPER MAINTENANCE INFORMATION TO THE CLIENT AT THE TIME OF ACCEPTANCE. DURING THE GUARANTEE PERIOD, DEAD OR DISCARDED MATERIALS SHALL BE REPLACED AT HIS COST TO THE FINCH. AT THE END OF THE GUARANTEE PERIOD, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL OBTAIN FINAL ACCEPTANCE FROM THE FINCH.
- ANY EXISTING TREES TO BE RETAINED SHALL BE PROTECTED FROM SOIL COMPACTION AND OTHER DAMAGES THAT MAY OCCUR DURING CONSTRUCTION ALLOWED BY EXISTING FENCING AROUND SUCH MATERIALS AT A DISTANCE OF 5.3 FROM THE TRUNK.
- ALL GRAVE CLUMPS, OTHER VEGETATION, TREES, STONES, ETC. SHALL BE MOVED ON CHAIRS REQUIRED FROM PLANTING AND LAYOUT AREAS PRIOR TO ACTIVATION OF INSTALLATION PROCEDURES.
- ANY AREAS TO BE LOWED AND SEEDED MUST HAVE NOT BEEN DISTURBED BY CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES SHALL BE PROTECTED FROM SOIL COMPACTED, EXISTING TREES, CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN TO NOT PLACE GREATER THAN 1" DEEP, UNEXPOSED ROOTS OF EXISTING TREES IN SUCH AREAS.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL VERIFY THE LOCATIONS OF ALL UNDERGROUND UTILITIES PRIOR TO INITIATING PLANTING OPERATIONS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY MULCH AND UTILITIES, GAS, CABLE, ETC. MUST BE MARKED AND BURIED IN A SAFE OPERATION.
- SEEDS AND PLANTING STANDARDS OF PLANT MATERIALS SHALL CONFORM TO THE LATEST EDITION OF ANY ADOPTED AMERICAN STANDARDS FOR NURSERY STOCK, BY THE AMERICAN NURSERY & LANDSCAPE ASSOCIATION.
- REFER TO PLAN OF SURVEY FOR LEGAL DESCRIPTION, BOUNDARY DIMENSIONS AND EASING CONVEYANCES.
- REFER TO ARCHITECTURAL PLANS FOR BUILDING MASS, SIZE, AND FOOTPRINT.
- REFER TO ENGINEERING PLANS FOR RETENTION CALCULATIONS, UTILITY LOCATIONS, TOPOGRAPHIC INFORMATION AND THE LIKE.
- PRELIMINARY LANDSCAPE PLAN MAY GREAT AND MINORITIES ARE APPROXIMATE.
- ALL PLANT MATERIAL ON THIS PLANTING PLAN REPRESENTS THE INTENDED AND INTENSITY OF PROPOSED LANDSCAPE MATERIAL, THE EXACT SPECIES AND LOCATIONS MAY VARY IN THE FIELD TO ACCOMMODATE THE SITE, THE SUBSEQUENTLY AND THE AVAILABILITY OF PLANT MATERIAL, AT THE TIME OF INSTALLATION. ANY SUCH CHANGES MUST FIRST BE APPROVED BY THE FINCH.
- ALL PLANT MATERIAL SHALL BE PLANTED WITH A MINIMUM OF 60 INCHES OF ORGANIC SOIL AND MULCHED WITH A THICKNESS OF 2" MINIMUM.
- ALL LAWN AREAS OF THIS PLAN SHALL BE ESTABLISHED USING SEED.
- THIS LANDSCAPE PLAN ASSUMES THE SITE WILL BE PREPARED WITH TOP SOIL. SUITABLE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE LANDSCAPE MATERIAL, PRESENTED ON THIS PLAN. IF ADDITIONAL TOP SOIL IS REQUIRED IT IS UP TO THE LANDSCAPE CONTRACTOR ON THE PROJECT TO PROVIDE SEED AND PREPARE THE SITE AS NEEDED FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS LANDSCAPE PLAN.
- CONTRACTOR MUST VERIFY ALL PERMITS AND OBTAIN ALL NECESSARY PERMITS AND LICENSES FROM THE PROPER AUTHORITIES.
- ALL MATERIAL MUST MEET INDUSTRY STANDARDS AND THE LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT HAS THE RIGHT TO REJECT ANY POOR MATERIAL OR NONCONFORMING.
- LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR UNUSUAL SITE CONDITIONS.
- ALL PLANTING SHALL BE SPACED EQUAL DISTANCE, PINK FILLED WITH ANDERSON SOIL IN A HOLE THREE TIMES THE POTENTIAL DRAINER, WATERED, FERTILIZED, FLEECED, AND HAVE ALL TAGS AND NOTES REMOVED.
- TREES SHALL BE STAKED AND GUINED, AND HAVE A WATERING TAPPER AT BASE.
- ALL BEDS TO BE BERMED 12" TO 24" ABOVE GROUND, AND MUST DRAINAGE REQUIREMENTS.
- LAWN AND BED AREAS SHALL BE MOTICULATED, RAKED OF CLUMPS AND BIRDS.
- CONTRACTOR SELECTED FOR PLANTING PLANT INSTALLATION SHOULD HAVE A MINIMUM OF 5 YEARS EXPERIENCE IN THE FIELD. SUPERVISOR SHOULD BE PRESENT ON SITE DURING LANDSCAPE WORK TO CORRECT AREAS THAT ON IDENTIFY NON-NATIVE AND PLANT PLANTS IN GRASS AND BIRDS.
- ALL SEED SPECIFIED ON THE SITE SHOULD BE TREATED WITH SEED SPECIFIC WEIGHTS AND DOCUMENTATION OF THIS TESTING TEST MUST MEET A MINIMUM TWO PLUS PER SPECIES AS VERIFIED BY INDEPENDENT LABORATORY TEST RESULTS AND MORE THAN A YEAR OLD FOR PRAIRIE GRASSES (SPERMATOPHYTES). TEST RESULTS SHALL BE NO MORE THAN 4 MONTHS OLD.
- FERTILIZER SHALL NOT BE USED IN AREAS OF NATIVE LANDSCAPE.
- ALL NATIVE SEED AND PLANT MATERIAL SHALL BE OBTAINED FROM SOURCES WITHIN A 250 MILE RADIUS FROM THE PROJECT SITE TO MAINTAIN LOCAL ECOTYPES.
- BROADCASTING OR HYDRIC SEEDING WILL BE USED FOR TREES OF PLANTING PLANTED AREAS. SEEDS, CONTROL, BROADCAST WILL BE USED WITH SEEDS WITH A BIRD OF A FEW INCHES. CONTROL PLANTING SHALL BE MADE ACCORD TO APPROVED LOCAL, WHEN BROADCAST SEEDING METHODS ARE USED THE SEEDS SHALL BE BROADCAST SUITABLY FROM THE FLOUNDER.
- WHEN BROADCAST SEED APPLICATION METHODS ARE USED SEEDS TO BE APPLIED AT DOUBLE
