






There is a mental health crisis in Illinois: A look at the data

Adults

- 38.5% of adults reported symptoms of anxiety or depression.
- 403,000 adults experienced serious mental illness.
- 376,000 adults in Illinois experienced suicidal ideation in the past year.
- 20% of adults with anxiety/depression needed but did not receive counseling.
- 486,000 adults in Illinois did not receive needed mental health care, 7.3% of those are uninsured.

Access & Workforce Gaps

- Illinois ranks 9th nationally for uninsured adults with mental illness and 28th for workforce availability
- 4,873,491 people in Illinois live in a community that does not have enough mental health professionals.

Youth

- 40% of surveyed Illinois high school students stated they felt sad or hopeless almost every day for 2 weeks or more, and 20% of high school students seriously considered attempting suicide in the past year.
- 90% of children who have had a major depressive episode in Illinois did not receive mental health treatment. Around 38.4% of Illinois's youth (aged 12 to 17) who underwent a major depressive episode received support for depression. This percentage is lower than the regional and national averages for youth who received depression care.
- 1 in 4 females and 1 in 8 males in middle and high school had seriously considered suicide in the past year.




Demographics Served: Ethnicity




Demographics Served: Gender and Age




Demographics Served: Language




Insurance Types



Mental Health Categories Observations by Age (total)




Mental Health Category by Age


