

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF ORLAND PARK, AS AMENDED (Section 6-304)

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Orland Park, an Illinois home rule municipality, have on February 8, 1991, adopted a Land Development Code ("the Code") and zoning map; and

WHEREAS, amendments to the Code are adopted from time to time to insure that the Code is up to date and responsive to community needs; and

WHEREAS, amendments were proposed to change the requirements for temporary sales in Section 6-304, "Temporary Uses"; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission of the Village held public hearings on February 23, 2010 and March 23, 2010 on whether the proposed amendments should be approved, at which time all persons present were afforded an opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, a public notice in the form required by law was given of said public hearing by publication not more than thirty (30) days nor less than fifteen (15) days prior to said hearing in the Orland Park Prairie, a newspaper of general circulation in this Village; and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission of this Village has filed its report of findings and recommendation that the proposed amendments to Section 6-304 of the Land Development Code of the Village be made, and this Board of Trustees has duly considered said report and findings and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, on July 6, 2010, the Village Board passed Ordinance No. 4574, which inadvertently deleted parts of Subsection 10 of Paragraph C of Section 6-304.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Orland Park, Cook and Will Counties, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION 1**

This Board finds and determines that the adoption of the following amendments to the Land Development Code of the Village of Orland Park is in the best interests of the Village and its residents, is in the public interest, constitutes an improvement to the Land Development Code of the Village of Orland Park, and is in keeping with the spirit and in furtherance of the purpose of the Land Development Code of the Village of Orland Park, as set forth in Section 1-102 thereof.

**SECTION 2**

The Land Development Code of the Village of Orland Park, as amended, is hereby further amended to delete in its entirety the text of Subsection 10 of Paragraph C,

“Permitted Temporary Uses” of Section 6-304 to substitute the following as new text for Subsection 10 of Paragraph C of Section 6-304

10. Temporary Sales.

- a. For existing onsite businesses, temporary sales of items including flowers, food, novelties, sidewalk sales, tent sales and special promotions shall be permitted in any district, provided that all sales are conducted at least thirty (30) feet from the right-of-way of any street or highway, and do not interfere with traffic.
- b. A drawing of the event location must accompany request for outdoor sales.
- c. Permit application is required.
- d. The maximum length of a permit will be three (3) days.
- e. Permits are limited to one (1) per month.
- f. In the event food is prepared for outside consumption, an inspection is required by the Village health inspector.
- g. Not more than ten (10) percent of the required parking spaces may be used for outdoor sales structure.

### SECTION 3

All sections of the Land Development Code not addressed in this Ordinance or another amending ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

### SECTION 4

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict herewith.

### SECTION 5

This Ordinance shall become and be effective immediately upon its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law. It is ordered that publication of this Ordinance be made by the duplication thereof in pamphlet form, said pamphlets to be deposited in the office of the Village Clerk of the Village of Orland Park, for general distribution.
