- Both sides of Tinley Creek banks are continuously eroding for years
- Private creek, ownership and maintenance are responsibilities of property owners
- Village or MWRD are not responsible for Creek maintenance



- Project started in 2012, and first engineering design was completed in 2014 by MWRD
- Village or MWRD could not secure easements and the project was stalled
- Project restarted in 2022 by the Village
 - MWRD maintained the original \$3.7 million construction grant
 - MWRD added an additional \$100K for design
 - Village is responsible for remaining design and construction costs



- Village and MWRD agreed to pay for the design and construction costs
- Village took responsibility of maintaining the improvements for life for those properties who voluntarily provided easements



- Properties that did offer easements voluntarily...
 - are removed from the project
 - are responsible for maintenance of their portions of creek for life

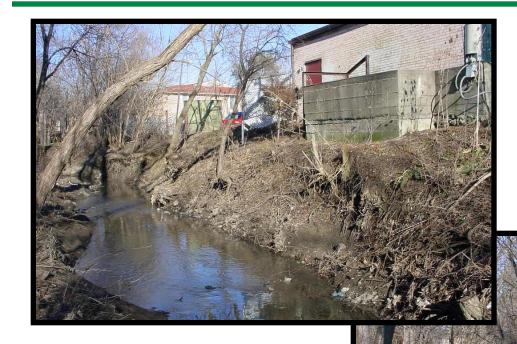

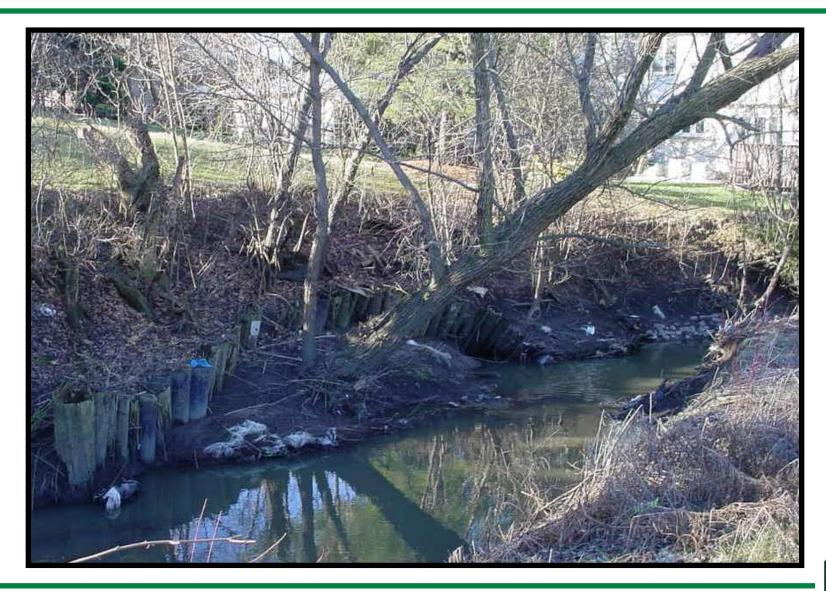

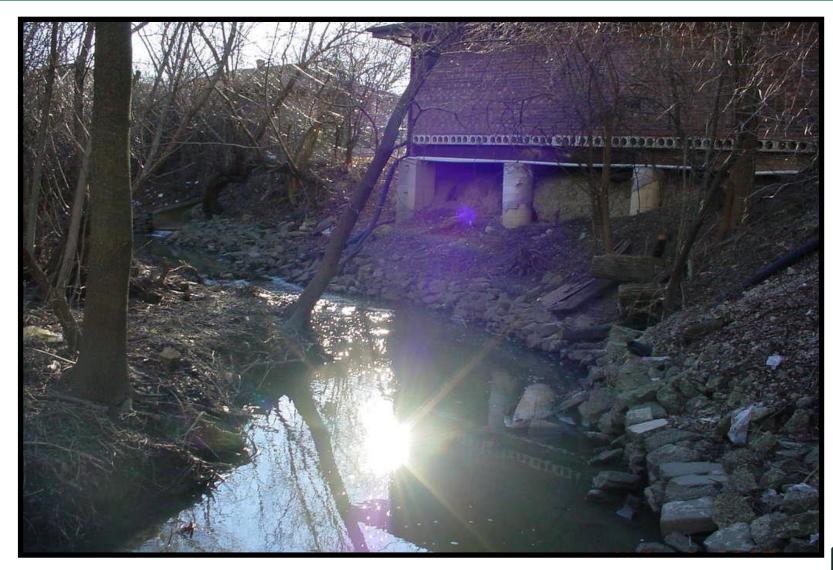

Properties Excluded from the Project

Excluded Properties

- Following properties did not offer easements voluntarily and are excluded from the project
 - 15437 Teebrook Drive
 - 8448 Teebrook Drive
 - 8430 Flamingo Circle
 - 8434 Flamingo Circle
- Legal letters were sent from the Village attorney to inform them they will be responsible for creek maintenance for life
- Must comply with Village and MWRD requirements





MWRD Participation

Excluded Properties

- MWRD is providing \$3.70 million for project construction.
- Construction contract meets all MWRD requirements for MBE participation
- Remaining construction contract meets
 Village's contractual requirements

Next Step

- Retain an engineering firm for Construction Engineering services
 - Construction observation
 - Project controls
 - Communication and coordination with residents
- RFP was issued on November 21, 2025





Construction Schedule

Construction Schedule

- Start in early 2026
- Estimated construction duration is 2026 construction season, weather dependent
- Some landscape items may be completed in 2027
