Justification for Sole Source

- 1. Since the 1990's all officers at the OPPD have been required to wear soft ballistic armor while on duty performing their daily responsibilities.
- 2. Over these decades the OPPD has utilized various manufacturers of soft ballistic armor, some of which being Point Blanc, Armor Express and now Safariland.
- 3. Nationally, ballistic vests only have a 5-year lifespan, per the manufacturers' warranties, therefore must be replaced at the end of those five years.
- 4. In 2022, the OPPD upgraded the quality and craftsmanship of our ballistic armor vests and vest carriers for the latest in lightweight, yet consistent protection levels, with the new Safariland Hardwire vests.
- 5. Streicher's, LLC is the regional distributor of Safariland merchandise.
- 6. Safariland falls under the NASPO contract pricing, however Streicher's provides an even better price than that offered under the contract.
- 7. In 2024, the OPPD purchased rifle rated ballistic plates for all officers from Safariland. These plates are designated as "In Conjunction With" plates. These plates must be worn along with the coordinating soft ballistic armor under them in order to be considered rifle rated protection. These soft ballistic vests (Hardwire) are those required to be worn under the rifle plates.
- 8. We have been purchasing these vests from Safariland for the last three years and these additional purchases will maintain continuity of operations.
