DCEO Grant

- The Village will receive a \$500,000 grant associated with Senate Bill 2510, Section 525, appropriated from the Build Illinois Bond Fund through the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO).
- Grant supports costs associated with improvements to Village parks.
- The grant is administered on a reimbursement basis and does not require a local match contribution.

DCEO GRANT

- Illinois House State Representative Mary Gill of the 35th District was instrumental in securing this funding.

DCEO Grant

- The project is anticipated to begin in early June and be substantially completed in 2026.
- As the planned improvements meet the intent and eligibility requirements of the DCEO grant program, staff seek authorization to utilize the grant funding to reimburse eligible project expenses.
- As the grant is reimbursable, a future budget amendment will be required to recognize both the associated project expenditures and grant reimbursement revenue
