Good afternoon stewards!

Another year's flown by us at what seems like record pace, and that means it about time to start talking about new stewardship contracts. But before looking to next year, I wanted to thank all of you and your crews for your work during the 2024 season. This was my first full year taking over after Josh left and, despite some speedbumps on my end in getting the new contracts rolling at the start, I think this year ran pretty well. A huge part of that was the great work each of you perform at all of the ponds you manage, so thank you again for your excellent service!

Last year we had quite a few ponds up for bid (38 new ponds added to the stewardship list, in addition to 17 more that were up for renewal) but this year the list is much smaller. There aren't any sites up for renewal this go around and I'm only adding eight (8) new ponds to the list, which you can see below. Just to map out the future a bit, assuming all the ponds remain on their 5-year contract cycles, next year will have no renewals needed, 2026 will have a few, and then '27 and '28 will each have A LOT.

A few special notes:

- Municipal Basin will need to be bid separate from the other basins, because it will be treated as a different PO than the other stewardships
 After a controlled burn to be performed this fall, Municipal Basin should be ready for immediate seeding and planting next year
- Both of the Deer Haven ponds (East and West) should be bid as a single stewardship item

• For Brown Park, we're mostly concerned about the channel running through it and making sure its shore stays healthy
