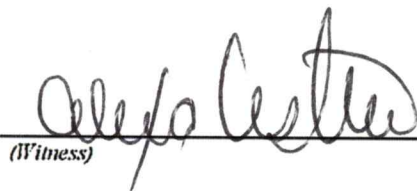

The conditions of this Bond are such that if the Owner accepts the bid of the Contractor within the time specified in the bid documents, or within such time period as may be agreed to by the Owner and Contractor, and the Contractor either (1) enters into a contract with the Owner in accordance with the terms of such bid, and gives such bond or bonds as may be specified in the bidding or Contract Documents, with a surety admitted in the jurisdiction of the Project and otherwise acceptable to the Owner, for the faithful performance of such Contract and for the prompt payment of labor and material furnished in the prosecution thereof; or (2) pays to the Owner the difference, not to exceed the amount of this Bond, between the amount specified in said bid and such larger amount for which the Owner may in good faith contract with another party to perform the work covered by said bid, then this obligation shall be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect. 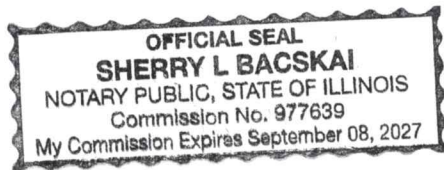

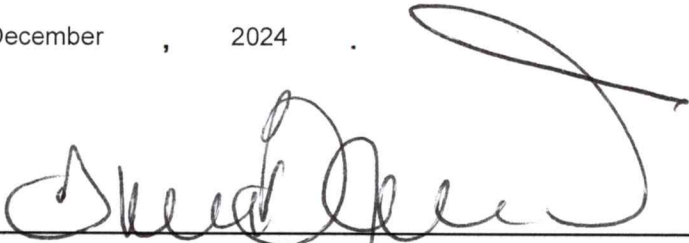

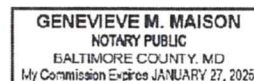

PROJECT DETAILS

Scope of Work

The Village of Orland Park requests bids for the replacement of a Corrugated Metal Pipe (CMP) that moves water underneath St. Michael's church parking lot, with a forty-two-inch (42") concrete pipe.

The project will have some unique challenges with Church services and the window of opportunity for work with the school summer break schedule.

The work will also include:

- installation of a storm sewer on Irving Ave.
- directional boring of an additional storm sewer to a backyard on Irving Ave.
- curb replacement
- sidewalk replacement
- asphalt replacement
- sod restoration
- parking lot closures and detour signage and planning
- working with the school and church to meet their needs within the parking lot during construction

All work will follow Village codes and specifications unless approved by Village staff.

Work can not start until June 9, 2025, and will need to be completed before the start of school on August 28, 2025.

LOCATION OF WORK AND SPECIFICATIONS:

It is expressly understood and agreed to by both Parties that in no event shall the total amount to be paid by the Village for the complete and satisfactory performance of services, exceed the proposed amount. Said price shall be the total compensation for Contractor's performance hereunder including, but not limited to, all work, deliverables, materials, supplies, equipment, subcontractor's fees, and all reimbursable travel and miscellaneous or incidental expenses to be incurred by Contractor. In the event the Contractor incurs cost in excess of the sum authorized for service, the Contractor shall pay such excess from its own funds, and the Village shall not be required to pay any part of such excess, and the Contractor shall have no claim against the Village on account thereof. For the avoidance of doubt, in no event shall Contractor be entitled to receive more than the proposed amount and this amount includes all costs incurred by Contractor in connection with the work and services authorized hereby, including, but not limited to: (i) any known or unknown and/or unexpected condition(s); (ii) any and all unforeseen difficulties; (iii) any unanticipated rises in the cost of labor, materials or equipment, changes in market or negotiating

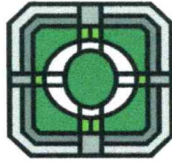
