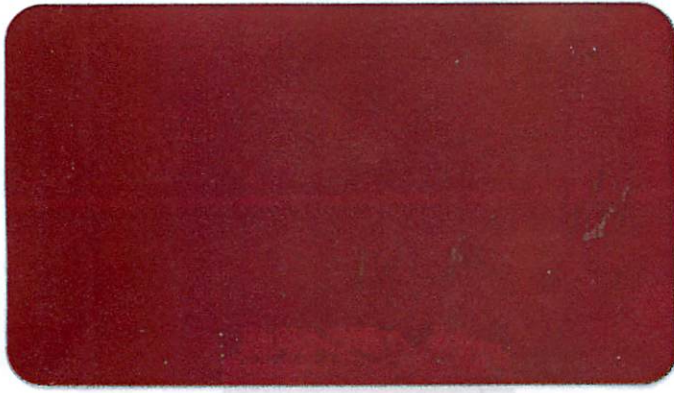

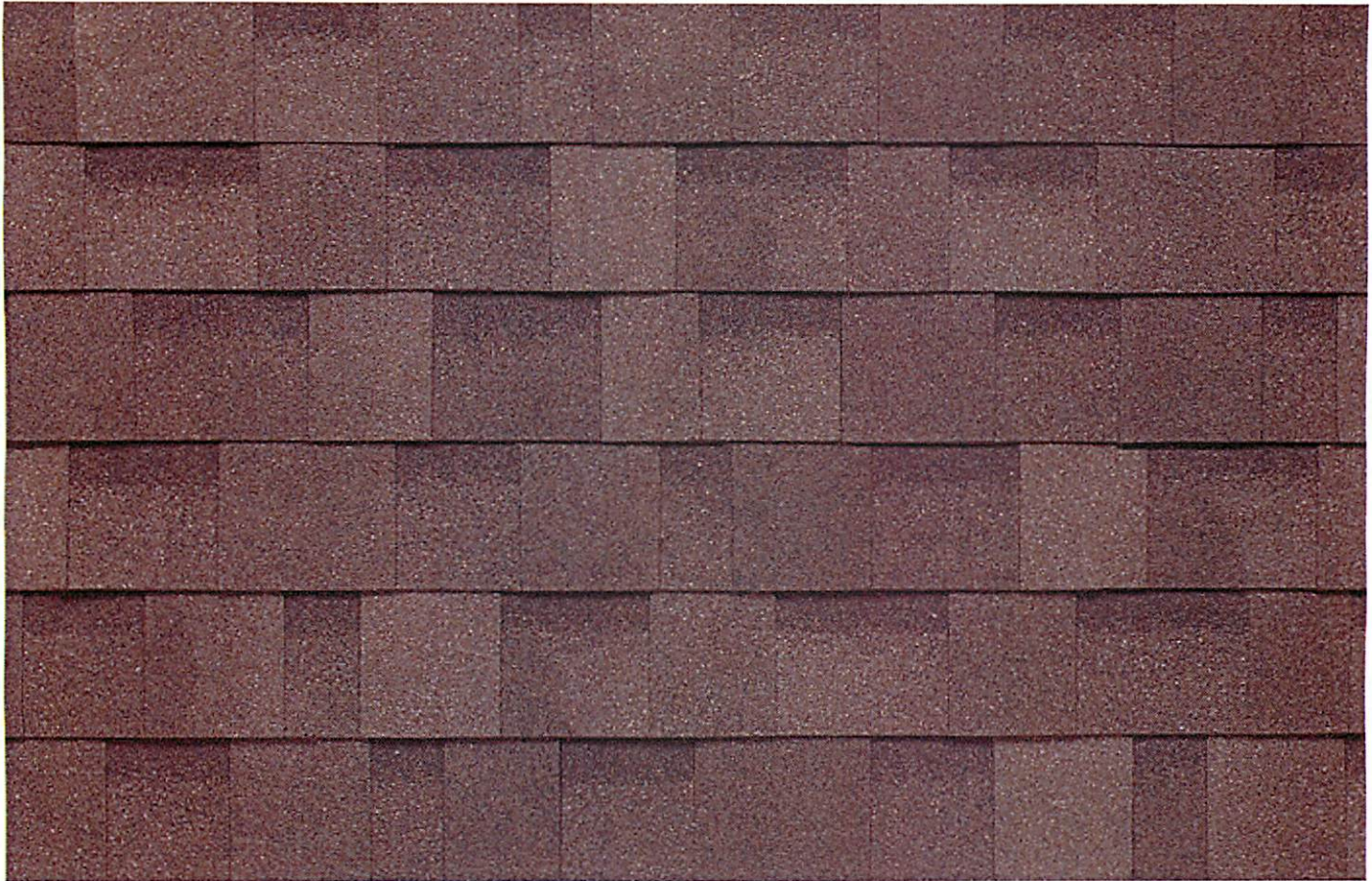


Gable Details, Facia, Soffit, Window & Corner Trim Boards, Porch Columns & baluster
