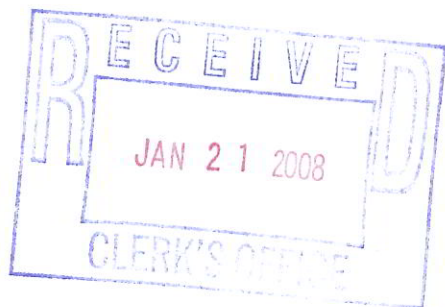

This notification is to inform you that on December 3, 2007, the Village of Orland Park Board of Trustees approved awarding Mid America Tree & Landscape, Inc. the contract in accordance with the bid you submitted dated October 30, 2007, for Turf Mowing for three years (2008, 2009, 2010) at the weekly rates of:

VILLAGE OF ORLAND PARK
TURF MOWING AGREEMENT
2008 - 2010

This Agreement is made and entered into this 20th day of December, 2007 by and between the *Village of Orland Park, a Municipal Corporation of the State of Illinois* (hereinafter designated as the "Village"), and *Mid-America Tree and Landscape, Inc., Mokena, IL* (hereinafter designated as the "Contractor").

WITNESSETH that for and in consideration of the premises and the mutual agreement and undertakings of the parties hereto, the Contractor agrees to complete a program of turf mowing and trimming as designated by the Village, and the Village agrees to pay for the same, all subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Provision of Labor, Tools and Equipment. The Contractor agrees to furnish and pay all necessary expenses for all labor, tools and equipment in connection with the program of turf mowing, edging and trimming as designated by the Village and shall meet the standards of the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Act and State of Illinois safety codes as may be required by law.
2. Observance of Laws and Ordinances. The Contractor shall at all times observe and comply with all laws, ordinances and regulations of the federal, state, local and village government, which may in any manner affect the performance of the contract. The Contractor shall secure all permits and licenses imposed by law and ordinance, pay all charges and fees, and give all notices necessary and incidental to the due and lawful prosecution of the work provided in this Agreement. The Contractor will observe all ordinances regarding the obstruction of streets and driveways, maintaining signals and open passageways, and protecting the same where exposed. Not less than the prevailing Rate of Wages as found by the Village of Orland Park or the Department of Labor, shall be paid to laborers, workmen and mechanics performing work under this contract. Any vendor doing work in the Village must obtain a contractor's license from the Village of Orland Park Building Department.
3. Payments to Other Parties. The Contractor shall not obligate the Village to make any payments to another party, nor make any promises or representations to another party for, or in behalf of, the Village without prior written approval of the Village Manager or his authorized representative. No work shall be done on any grass or brush involved in such payments, promises or representations until such approval of the Village Manager or his authorized representative has been obtained.
4. Description of Work. The Contractor agrees to trim, maintain and mow the grass on certain areas in the manner specified in this Agreement. The work shall consist of mowing, grounds maintenance, string trimming, debris removal as necessary, and other such work as required for the maintenance of designated areas and properties for the Village of Orland Park.

All work will be completed within a five (5) day rotation, Monday through Friday, as directed by the Director of Public Works and Director of Parks. Variations in mowing schedule may be required due to scheduling of programs in parks. The season will begin as determined by the Director of Public Works and the Director of Parks and generally end on October 30th. The Director of Public Works and Director of Parks will determine such schedules based on weather conditions. Mowing during drought conditions may be suspended. Mowing during wet periods may be increased to twice per week for parks. Sufficient equipment and personnel must be available to handle the added load. The specific areas involved are listed in the Appendix, which is incorporated herein and shall be construed as part of this Agreement.

The Village may, at its discretion, select individual sites not to be mowed or be mowed on a different schedule. The Village may add sites not currently listed. The cost of mowing these sites will be determined by multiplying the mowable acreage by the "site additions cost per acre."

"Nuisance mowing" is the mowing of private property for the Village, that is neglected by the owner. It is done on an as needed basis when requested by the Village.

Specifications for the work to be performed by the Contractor will be as follows:

- a. Mowing. The Contractor will mow the areas listed in the Appendix as often as necessary to assure that the grass height does not exceed three and one-half (3 1/2) inches in length. To avoid damaging the grass, the Contractor will not mow to a height of less than two and one-half (2-1/2) inches.

Landscape berms, hills, or similar areas will be hand mowed to prevent scalping.

All mowing will be scheduled on a weekly basis, depending on the month or weather conditions, as designated by the Director of Public Works and the Director of Parks.

Clippings may not be blown into any pond, flow channel, street, sidewalk or parking area.

Clippings will be removed where grass clippings are not spread evenly over an area.

Excessive clippings due to tall grass shall be removed at the discretion of the Director of Public Works or the Director of Parks.

Each mowing site shall be completed on the same day mowing is commenced for that location.

All mowing will extend to the edge of the road pavement.

- b. Trimming. All sites shall be neatly trimmed. The Contractor will hand trim the grass around curbs, trees, bushes, planting beds, swales, utility poles, sign posts, playground equipment, fencing, asphalt, structures, light poles, concrete curbs, foot paths, paved area, rip rapped culverts, drainage swales and concrete drainage troughs and other objects as required to provide a uniform appearance. The trimming must be done on the same day as the mowing.
- c. Litter and Debris. All debris, paper, glass, etc., shall be picked up and removed from the site prior to mowing. The Contractor may dispose of such items in the dumpster located at the Public Works Building. When finished mowing, the Contractor will sweep and remove any grass clippings from curbs, sidewalks or streets adjoining the areas.
- d. Reporting of Damage. The Contractor will report any vandalism or storm damage to the work areas, or to any of the trees, bushes or objects located in the contracted area to the Village as soon as possible. Contractor is responsible for any damage to turf areas, plant material, park equipment, park facilities and any adjoining properties, caused by the mowing operation.

5. Work Schedule. The work performed by the Contractor as described in this Agreement will begin at the discretion of the Director of Public Works and the Director of Parks through the last Friday in October, during the same calendar year.
6. Hours of Work. The Contractor shall work between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. except Sunday and holidays recognized by the Village. In addition, no park or pond adjacent to a park shall be mowed on Saturdays.
7. Equipment. The Contractor is responsible for providing, maintaining and transporting all necessary equipment, and fuel for its use, in connection with the program of turf mowing and trimming described in this Agreement. Equipment used on all sports fields must have flotation tires to eliminate rutting. All lawn and grass mower blades must be kept sufficiently sharp to provide a clean and even cut. Safety shielding and other manufacturer safety amenities on all mowing equipment shall remain attached at all times. The Contractor will provide all other tools and supplies necessary for performing the work required by this Agreement. All tools and equipment required to carry out the operations within the scope of this contract shall meet the standards of the Federal Occupational Safety and Health Act and State of Illinois safety codes as may be required by law. The Village reserves the right to inspect the equipment that will be used.
8. Specifications and Bid Proposal. The specifications and bid proposal submitted by the Contractor shall be incorporated herein and are to be construed as part of this Agreement. If the Village requests and accepts bids or quotations for additional mowing and trimming work which the Contractor agrees to provide, such bids or quotations shall be incorporated herein and are to be construed as part of this Agreement.
9. Personnel. The Contractor's personnel shall, at all times, present a neat appearance, and all work shall be performed and all complaints handled with due regard to the Village public relations. The Village and the Contractor will each be promptly notified by the other of any complaints received from the property owners. The Contractor shall utilize competent employees in performing the work specified in this Agreement. At the request of the Village Manager, the Contractor will replace any incompetent, unfaithful, abusive or disorderly person in his or her employ.
10. Supervision, Consultation and Reporting. It is agreed that the Village Manager or his authorized representative and the Contractor must mutually understand work priorities, maintenance methods and management techniques. Upon request and/or necessity, an authorized municipal representative will accompany the Contractor to work areas to further clarify or describe maintenance methods and procedures. All work described in this Agreement shall be performed under the guidance of the Village Manager or his authorized representative and subject to his approval. A written report shall be submitted at the conclusion of each day during the period covered by this contract. All such notifications shall include the following information:
 - Location
 - Site number
 - Date of mowing
 - Start time; end time

This notification may be faxed to the Director of Public Works at 708-403-8798 or delivered to the Public Works Department and faxed to the Director of Parks at 708-403-6289 or delivered to the Parks Department. A sample Turf Mowing Completion Report is included in the Appendix, which is incorporated herein and shall be construed as part of this Agreement.

11. Obstruction of Streets and Rights of Way. The Contractor will arrange to keep sidewalks open for traffic whenever possible and will block portions of streets only when deemed necessary to protect private property. Warning signs and barricades shall be furnished and erected by the Contractor when warranted. It is the Contractor's responsibility to remove all surplus material and debris from streets as work progresses in order that the public will have adequate use of the affected streets.
12. Accident Prevention. The Contractor shall exercise precaution at all times for the protection of persons and property. Safety provisions of all applicable laws and ordinances shall be strictly observed. The Village Manager or his authorized representative may require the Contractor to discontinue hazardous work practices upon written notice. It is required that the Contractor keep the necessary guards and protective devices at locations where work is being performed to prevent injury to the public or damage to public or private property.
13. Payment for Services. Payment terms shall be pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Prompt Payment Act (50 ILCS 505/1 *et seq.*) after receipt by the Village of Contractor's Dated Invoice for the amount being requested. Invoices should include the following information:
 - Name and Address of contractor
 - Purchase order number
 - Dates of Service
 - Current Invoice Amount

Contractor shall bill each department separately. The Village shall be billed monthly for services rendered no later than the 10th of the month following the application period. All invoices must show the location of the work being performed, site identification number, and the date of completion. If an individual site is unable to be mowed in its entirety, the cost for mowing shall be prorated for the amount actually mowed. All work shall be inspected and approved before any payment is authorized by the Director of Public Works or the Director of Parks. The Village reserves the right to withhold payment for any work not completed to the satisfaction of the Village.

For "nuisance mowing" the Village requires invoices be sent within 30 days for work performed.

14. Insurance. Contractor shall purchase and maintain such insurance as will protect it from claims as set forth below which may arise out of or result from Contractors operations under this Agreement, whether such operations be by it or by a subcontractor or by anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them, or by anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable:
 - a. Claims under Workers or Workmens Compensation disability benefit and other similar employee benefit acts;
 - b. Claims for damages due to bodily injury, occupational sickness or disease or death of an employee or employees;
 - c. Claims for damages due to bodily injury, sickness or disease, or death of any person other than employees;
 - d. Claims for damages insured by usual personal injury liability coverage, which are sustained (1) by any person as a result of an offense directly or indirectly related to the employment of such person by Contractor, or (2) by any other person;

- e. Claims for damages because of injury to or destruction of tangible property, including loss of use resulting there from; and
- f. Claims for damages because of bodily injury or death of any person or property damage arising out of the ownership, lease, maintenance or use of any motor vehicle.

The insurance required by this section shall be written in the statutory amounts with respect to Workers or Workmens Compensation and with limits of liability with respect to injury to persons or death to persons and damage to property as follows: \$500,000 each person, \$500,000 each occurrence and \$500,000 property damage. Said insurance shall be placed with companies acceptable to the Village and any insurance company providing coverage must hold an A VI rating according to Bests Key Rating Guide. The Contractor shall provide the Village with a certificate issued by the insurance carrier or broker within ten (10) days after the execution of the Contract with evidence in insurance coverage naming the Village, its trustees, officers, employees and agents as additional insureds providing for the coverages and minimum limits as set forth above. The Contractor shall provide insurance to the Village on a primary and non-contributory basis and all contracts of insurance shall provide for thirty (30) days advance written notice to the Village of cancellation thereof. The Contractor further agrees to cause Contractual Liability Endorsements to be issued by the insurance companies (and attached to the policies of insurance applicable to the work) to include under the coverage therein extended an obligation on the part of the insurers to insure against the Contractors contractual liability hereunder and to indemnify the Village against loss, liability, costs, expenses, attorney fees and court costs.

Endorsements to the policies shall include as named co-insureds the Village and its trustees, officers, employees and agents.

All insurance required of the Contractor shall state that it is Primary Insurance as to all additional insureds with respect to all claims arising out of operation by or on their behalf. If additional insureds have other applicable insurance coverage it shall be regarded as on an excess or contingent basis. The purchase of insurance by the Contractor under this Contract shall not be deemed to limit the liability of the Contractor in any way, for damages suffered by the Village and its trustees, officers, employees and agents in excess of policy limits or not covered by the policies purchased.

The Contractor and all employees or agents of the Contractor assume all risk and danger incidental to the Contractors obligations and operations provided in this Agreement. The Contractor agrees that neither the Village nor any of its trustees, officials, employees, agents or representatives shall be liable for injuries (including death) arising out of the Contractors obligations and operations provided in this Agreement. The Contractor and all employees or agents of the Contractor do hereby forever release, remise and discharge the Village of and from any and all manner of actions, causes of action, claims and demands whatsoever and howsoever occurring for reason of injuries (including death) to person or property, arising out of the Contractors obligations and operations provided in this Agreement.

15. Liquidated Damages. If the Contractor fails to perform the work in the manner specified by this Agreement, the Village may, at its option, assess the Contractor for each day that the work is not performed. Before assessing liquidated damages, the Village will notify the Contractor of the problem and allow the Contractor twenty-four (24) hours to take corrective action. If, after further written notice, the Contractor fails to take corrective action the Village may terminate this Agreement and enter into an agreement with another contractor, or may perform the work itself. The cost of performing the work will be deducted from any amount due under the Payment for Services schedule.

16. Hold Harmless. Contractor agrees, at its sole cost and expense, to indemnify, save harmless and defend the Village, its trustees, officers, agents, servants and employees, and each of them, against and hold it and them harmless from any and all lawsuits, claims, demands, liabilities, losses or expenses, including court costs and attorneys fees, for or on account of any injury to any person, or any death at any time resulting from such injury, or any damage to any property, which may arise or which may be alleged to have arisen out of or in connection with the work or services covered by this Agreement. The foregoing indemnity shall apply except if such injury, death or damage is caused directly by the negligence or other fault of the Village, its trustees, officers, agents, servants or employees, or any other person indemnified hereunder.

In the event that the Village and/or its officers, trustees, agents, and/or employees is/are named as (a) defendant(s) in any lawsuit arising out of or resulting from the performance of or failure to perform the work by Contractor, any subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them or anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable, the Village and its officers, trustees, agents and employees shall have the right to choose the attorney(s) who represent(s) them in said lawsuit, and the costs, expenses and fees associated with said attorney(s) in relation to said lawsuit shall be paid by Contractor pursuant to the indemnification provisions herein.

In any and all claims against the Village, its officers, trustees, agents or employees by an employee of Contractor, any subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them or anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable, the indemnification obligation under this provision shall not be limited in any way by any limitation on the amounts or type of damages, compensation, or benefits payable by or for Contractor or any subcontractor under Workers or Workmen's Compensation Acts, disability benefit acts or other employee benefit acts.

17. Termination of Contract. The Village reserves the right to terminate the whole or any part of this contract, upon written notice to the Contractor, in the event that sufficient funds to complete the contract are not appropriated by the Village of Orland Park Board of Trustees.

The Village further reserves the right to terminate the whole or any part of this contract, upon written notice to the Contractor or Vendor in the event of default by the Contractor or Vendor. Default is defined as failure of the Contractor to perform any of the provisions of this contract in accordance with its terms. In the event of default and termination, the Village may procure, upon such terms and services similar to those so terminated. The Contractor shall be liable for any excess costs for such similar supplies or service unless acceptable evidence is submitted to the Director of Public Works and the Director of Parks that failure to perform the contract due to causes beyond the control and without fault or negligence of the Contractor or Vendor.

18. Notice. Where notice is required by the Contract Documents it shall be considered received if it is delivered in person, sent by registered United States mail, return receipt requested, delivered by messenger or mail service with a signed receipt, sent by facsimile or e-mail with an acknowledgement of receipt, to the following:

EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

Section I. This EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY CLAUSE is required by the Illinois Human Rights Act and the Rules and Regulations of the Illinois Department of Human Rights published at 44 Illinois Administrative Code Section 750, et seq.

Section II. C. That, in all solicitations or advertisements for employees placed by it or on its behalf, it will state that all applicants will be afforded equal opportunity without discrimination because of race, color, religion, sex, marital status, national origin or ancestry, age, or physical or mental handicap unrelated to ability, or an unfavorable discharge from military service.

D. That it will send to each labor organization or representative of workers with which it has or is bound by a collective bargaining or other agreement or understanding, a notice advising such labor organization or representative of the Contractor's obligations under the Illinois Human Rights Act and Department's Rules and Regulations for Public Contract.

E. G. That it will include verbatim or by reference the provisions of this Equal Employment Opportunity Clause in every subcontract it awards under which any portion of this Agreement obligations are undertaken or assumed, so that such provisions will be binding upon such subcontractor. For the purposes of subsection G of Section II, "subcontract" means any agreement, arrangement or understanding, written or otherwise, between the Contractor and any person under which any portion of the Contractor's obligations under one or more public contracts is performed, undertaken or assumed; the term "subcontract", however, shall not include any agreement, arrangement or understanding in which the parties stand in the relationship of an employer and an employee, or between a Contractor or other organization and its customers.

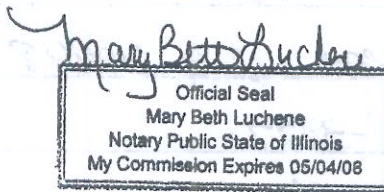
