Below is a brief summary related to the preferred design submitted by the Hari Group for Dave's Hot Chicken to the Orland Park Development Services Department ("Development Services") that was denied by the same department.

The Hari Group submitted its proposed signage for the Orland Park Dave's location to Development Services for an appearance review pursuant to Section 6-307(D)(2). The original proposed design included natural wood paneling, vibrant, colorful artwork appearing as breaks in the paneling, large white lettering outlined with red lighting, and a red halo light atop of the restaurant. The original proposed design is depicted below in Figure 1.
