



# Weapon Arrests

- Orland Park Police Department (OPPD) made forty-six (46) firearm arrests from January 1, 2019 through April 2021.
- This equates to a firearm arrest approximately once every two and one half weeks throughout this time frame.
- In 2021, a firearm arrest occurs once per week.




# Average Number of Weapon Arrests Per Week







# Unlawful Use of Weapon (UUW) Offenses

# Aggravated UUW Class 4 Felony

- OPPD charged thirty (30) cases with this offense.
- Nine (9) cases were issued I Bonds for this class of offense. In one (1) case, the offender was held No Bond, because he was on bond for an Armed Robbery when arrested by OPPD.
- In another case, the charges were dismissed by the Cook County State's Attorney's Office at the bond hearing.

# Prior Gun Convictions

- OPPD arrested six (6) offenders who had previous gun arrests and convictions.
- Three (3) of the offenders are now charged with Armed Habitual Criminal.
- In two (2) cases, the defendant's previous gun case was reduced from a felony to a misdemeanor.



# Armed Habitual Criminal ?

- If he or she receives, sells, possesses, or transfers any firearm after having been ***convicted a total of 2 or more times*** of any combination of the following offenses:
  - Forcible felony, felony weapon offenses; vehicular hijacking; aggravated vehicular hijacking; aggravated battery of a child; aggravated battery with a firearm; home invasion; or Class 3 and above drug offenses.

# Armed Habitual Criminal Class X Offense

- OPPD charged three (3) offenders with this offense.
- Two (2) cases had D bonds ordered. The average bond amount for release was \$5,000 to be posted.
- One (1) defendant was issued a \$100,000 *Bond*.

Class X Felony sentence - up to 30 years in prison and  
a \$25,000 fine.

# On Bond/Parole/Probation When Arrested

- A total of eight (8) offenders were on bond, parole or probation when arrested by OPPD with a firearm.
- Four (4) were on bond for the offenses including:
  - Armed Robbery
  - Aggravated Battery to a Police Officer
  - Delivery of a Controlled Substance
  - Retail Theft



# On Bond/Parole/Probation When Arrested

- Two (2) were on parole from Illinois Department of Corrections.
- The parole offenses were: Robbery, Arson and Aggravated UUW (all one offender), and UUW/Felon.
- Two (2) were on probation for the offenses of: Retail Theft (on probation for *four* felony retail theft cases) and another for an Aggravated UUW.

# Failure to Appear in Court

- Eight (8) defendants failed to appear in Cook County Circuit Court on ***at least*** one occasion while on bond for their OPPD gun offense.
- Three (3) defendants had been released on Court ordered I Bonds when they failed to appear.
- Three (3) defendants currently have warrants outstanding for their arrest.

# Violated Terms of Bond

- 22% of the gun offenders violated the terms of their release on bond by either committing a new offense while on bond or failing to appear in court.

Two (2) defendants violated their bond by committing a *new* offense and failing to appear in court.
