DC Rafferty,

Thank you so much for reaching out.

My rate is \$125 per officer for a 45 minute mental health screening. For 129 officers, that would be \$125 x 129 = \$16,125.

I offer a continued consultation option if you were interested in that, as well. Continued consultation includes access to contact me throughout the year if an individual officer is in need of further assistance, i.e. immediate psychiatric assistance, referrals to mental health programming or counseling, etc. My rate for continued consultation is \$10 per month per officer. Should you opt to include that, it would be \$10 x 12 x 129 = \$15,480 additional for a total of \$31,605. I do not require you to opt into the continued consultation, it is entirely your choice. The continued consultation provides individual officers the ability to contact me should they feel the need to, and is not meant to be used for community incidents. Please know that as my client, if you or anyone else at an administrative level feels an officer is experiencing a psychiatric emergency, I would assist if I am able to regardless. I have a deep passion for officer wellness, and my primary duty is to help.

That being said, I work alone meaning that it would take some time for me to complete 129 sessions, but it is something I am willing to explore if you are okay moving at my pace as I do work full time for the New Lenox Police Department as their social services provider. The only requirement I have of you is to provide a quiet location in your department that has a door that can be closed. I have attached my consent to treat, notice of privacy practices, and contract for your review. Note the contract is preloaded with last year's information from Manhattan as an example.
