I am requesting that you have the Village attorney review the relationship between Milliman and Jim Dodge. I would like full disclosure to include \_

- Scope of services performed
- Time frame employed / contracted with Milliman.
- Names of any other companies that have business relationships with the mayor.
- Reason for termination of services
- Any deferred commissions existing or future balances to be paid / received
- Other disclosures that would be relevant.(stock ownership, options, other partnerships, etc.)
- Any other current or former employees of Orland Park that have a relationship with Milliman or any other vendor.
- When was the last time Jim Dodge received compensation from Milliman or its affiliates.

I request that Jim's answers be in writing to prevent misinterpretation.

I loathe the idea of discussing the relationship in an open meeting until we have some answers and to let Jim put the relationship out there. I do not want a public display of animosity or at least limit it for the sake of the Village and not to undermine Jim's agenda. My gut tells me that Jim has a legitimate excuse for not informing the board that he is or was a senior adviser, employee or partner with this vendor (agent).

I do not have Jim's email address, but please send a copy to him as soon as possible.
