My name is John Bartgen and I am the head bass fishing coach at Victor J Andrew HS in Tinley. I am writing you to ask permission to host a D230 ice fishing event on Lake Sedgewick sometime in Feb. The event would be on a Saturday or a Sunday and is weather pending, so an exact date is not yet known. We received permission to host this event last winter, and the event went so good, we would love to do it again if allowed to do so. We recognize safety as a top priority and would only consider having this event if the ice was 8in or thicker, which is the same number as last year when we proposed the idea. We would also contact the Orland/Tinley fire departments and ask if they would be able to attend our event as a safety measure. Last year, the Orland fire department did attend our event and they stated that if we did do this again that they would be happy to help us out. This would be considered a school event so insurance is covered by D230. Please let me know if you need anymore information regarding this.
