VILLAGE OF ORLAND PARK
(Contract for Purchase of Goods and Services)

This Contract is made this 26th day of November, 2007 by and between the Village of Orland Park (hereinafter referred to as the "VILLAGE") and Sirius Computer Solutions, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "CONTRACTOR").

WITNESSETH

In consideration of the promises and covenants made herein by the VILLAGE and the CONTRACTOR (hereinafter referred to collectively as the "PARTIES"), the PARTIES agree as follows:

SECTION 1: THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS: This Contract shall include the following documents (hereinafter referred to as the "CONTRACT DOCUMENTS") however this Contract takes precedence and controls over any contrary provision in any of the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS. The Contract, including the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, expresses the entire agreement between the PARTIES and where it modifies, adds to or deletes provisions in other CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, the Contract's provisions shall prevail. Provisions in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS unmodified by this Contract shall be in full force and effect in their unaltered condition.

- The Proposal dated October 18, 2007, including the Statement of Work, as it is responsive to the VILLAGE's RFP requirements

SECTION 2: GOODS TO BE PURCHASED, COST AND DELIVERY, SCOPE OF THE WORK AND PAYMENT: The VILLAGE agrees to purchase from the CONTRACTOR the following:

Including all components as defined in the detailed hardware and software configuration as specified on pages 35 to 41 of the RFP for a total cost of Seventy Thousand Six Hundred Eighty and 10/100 (\$70,680.10) Dollars

(hereinafter referred to as the "GOODS") as further described in the VILLAGE'S RFP requirements. The GOODS shall be delivered FOB to the Village of Orland Park, 14700 South Ravinia Avenue, Orland Park, Illinois 60462 or to any other address provided by the VILLAGE.

The CONTRACTOR agrees to provide labor, equipment and materials necessary to provide the services as described in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS (hereinafter referred to as the "WORK") and further described below:

System I to System I Migration With i5/OS Upgrade Services as specified in the RFP response Statement of Work For a total cost of Seven Thousand and No/100 (\$7,000.00) Dollars.

The VILLAGE agrees to pay the CONTRACTOR upon acceptance of the GOODS and WORK pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Prompt Payment Act (50 ILCS 505/1 *et seq.*) the following for performance of the described services and upon acceptance of the GOODS:

TOTAL COST: Seventy Seven Thousand Six Hundred Eighty and 10/100 (\$77,680.10) Dollars (hereinafter referred to as the "CONTRACT SUM"). The CONTRACT SUM shall not be increased without the express written consent of the VILLAGE.

SECTION 3: ASSIGNMENT: CONTRACTOR shall not assign the duties and obligations involved in the performance of the WORK which is the subject matter of this Contract without the express written consent of the VILLAGE.

SECTION 4: TERM OF THE CONTRACT: This Contract shall commence on the date of its execution. The CONTRACTOR shall deliver the GOODS within 60 days of the date of execution of this Contract. Time is of the essence of this Contract. Acceptance of the GOODS and termination of this Contract shall occur only after the VILLAGE has inspected the GOODS, any period of training provided by the CONTRACTOR or manufacturer of the GOODS has expired and the GOODS have been acknowledged in writing by the VILLAGE to be accepted. In addition to any time period allotted for training purposes, the VILLAGE shall either issue said acknowledgement or a written notice explaining the deficiencies in the GOODS within ten (10) days of delivery. The CONTRACTOR shall have ten (10) days after receipt of notice of deficiencies to cure said deficiencies or replace the GOODS at which time, if the VILLAGE does not accept the GOODS the CONTRACTOR shall be considered to be in breach of the terms of the Contract.

The WORK shall commence upon receipt of a Notice to Proceed and continue expeditiously for 3 months from that date or until final completion. This Contract shall terminate upon completion of the WORK or one year, whichever occurs first, but may be terminated by either of the PARTIES for default upon failure to cure after ten (10) days prior written notice of said default from the aggrieved PARTY. The VILLAGE, for its convenience, may terminate this Contract with thirty (30) days prior written notice.

SECTION 5: INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE: To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Contractor shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the VILLAGE and their respective officers, agents and employees, from and against all claims, damages, losses, costs, expenses, judgments and liabilities, including but not limited to attorney's fees, costs and expenses, arising out of or in connection with Contractor's performance of or failure to perform this Agreement, provided that any such claim, damage, loss, costs, expenses, judgments or liabilities are attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or to injury or destruction of tangible personal property, including the loss of use resulting therefrom, that is caused in whole or in part by any act or omission of the Contractor, any subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by them or anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable.

The indemnification obligation under this paragraph shall not be limited in any way by any limitations on the amount or type of damages, compensation or benefits payable by or for the benefit of Contractor or any indemnities under any Worker's Compensation Act, Occupational Disease Act, Disability Benefits Act, or any other employee benefits act. The Contractor further agrees to waive any and all liability limitations based upon the Worker's Compensation Act court interpretations or otherwise.

Contractor agrees that a similar waiver of liability limitation will be incorporated in its agreements with sub-subcontractors or anyone directly or indirectly employed by them. Contractor agrees that in the event it fails to incorporate such a waiver of liability limitation in its agreements with said sub-subcontractors and others, then it will be responsible for any additional liability arising out of said failure. The defense and indemnification obligations set forth in this provision shall survive the termination or expiration of this Agreement.

Execution of this Contract by the VILLAGE is contingent upon receipt of any Insurance Certificates required by the VILLAGE in the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS.

SECTION 6: COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS: CONTRACTOR agrees to comply with all federal, state and local laws, ordinances, statutes, rules and regulations including but not limited to the Illinois Human Rights Act as explained in the Terms and Conditions herein and as follows: CONTRACTOR hereby agrees that this contract shall be performed in compliance with all requirements of the Illinois Human Rights Act, 775 ILCS 5/1-101 et seq., and that the CONTRACTOR and its subcontractors and any suppliers shall not engage in any prohibited form of discrimination in employment as defined in that Act and shall maintain a sexual harassment policy as the Act requires. The CONTRACTOR shall maintain, and require that its subcontractors and suppliers maintain, policies of equal employment opportunity which shall prohibit discrimination against any employee or applicant for employment on the basis of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, ancestry, citizenship status, age, marital status, physical or mental disability unrelated to the individual's ability to perform the essential functions of the job, association with a person with a disability, or unfavorable discharge from military service. CONTRACTOR and all subcontractors and suppliers shall comply with all requirements of the Act and of the Rules of the Illinois Department of Human Rights with regard to posting information on employees' rights under the Act. CONTRACTOR and all subcontractors and suppliers shall place appropriate statements identifying their companies as equal opportunity employers in all advertisements for workers to be employed in work to be performed under this contract.

The CONTRACTOR shall obtain all necessary local and state licenses and/or permits that may be required for performance of the WORK and provide those licenses to the VILLAGE prior to commencement of the WORK.

SECTION 7: NOTICE: Where notice is required by the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS, it requires that such notice be in writing. Notice shall be deemed received if it is 1) delivered in person, 2) sent by registered United States mail and a signed return receipt is received, 3) delivered by messenger or mail service and a signed receipt is received, 4) sent by facsimile and a printed acknowledgment of receipt is received, or 4) by e-mail if an acknowledgment of receipt is received. SECTION 8: TERMINATION: This Contract may be terminated by the VILLAGE for cause or convenience upon written notice to CONTRACTOR and in the case of GOODS manufactured or modified to the VILLAGE'S specifications, only upon payment of the costs incurred, as approved by the VILLAGE, up to the date of termination.

SECTION 9: STANDARD OF SERVICE: Services shall be rendered to the highest professional standards to meet or exceed those standards met by others providing the same or similar services in the Chicagoland area. Sufficient competent personnel shall be provided who with supervision shall complete the services required within the time allowed for performance. The CONTRACTOR'S personnel shall, at all times present a neat appearance and shall be trained to handle all contact with Village residents or Village employees in a respectful manner. At the request of the Village Manager or a designee, the CONTRACTOR shall replace any incompetent, abusive or disorderly person in its employ.

SECTION 10: PAYMENTS TO OTHER PARTIES: The CONTRACTOR shall not obligate the VILLAGE to make payments to third parties or make promises or representations to third parties on behalf of the VILLAGE without prior written approval of the Village Manager or a designee.

SECTION 11: COMPLIANCE: CONTRACTOR shall comply with all of the requirements of the Contract Documents, including, but not limited to, the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act where applicable and all other applicable local, state and federal statutes, ordinances, codes, rules and regulations.

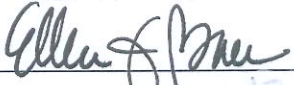
SECTION 12: LAW AND VENUE: The laws of the State of Illinois shall govern this Contract and venue for legal disputes shall be Cook County, Illinois.

SECTION 13: MODIFICATION: This Contract may be modified only by a written amendment signed by both PARTIES.

SECTION 14: COUNTERPARTS: This Contract may be executed in two (2) or more counterparts, each of which taken together, shall constitute one and the same instrument.

This Contract shall become effective on the date first shown herein and upon execution by duly authorized agents of the PARTIES.

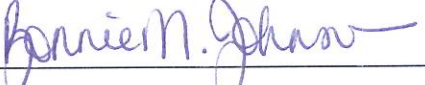

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF GOODS

The VILLAGE may, if the CONTRACTOR does not correct deficiencies in the GOODS with reasonable promptness after receiving a written notice from the VILLAGE, deduct the reasonable cost of the correction or cure from the amounts owed to the CONTRACTOR or require the CONTRACTOR to retrieve the GOODS at its sole expense and deduct the full amount of the returned GOODS from the CONTRACT SUM.

The CONTRACTOR represents to its knowledge and belief that the GOODS are new, contain materials of good quality and that the GOODS conform to the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS. All manufacturers' guarantees and warranties shall be delivered to the VILLAGE prior to the issuance of final payment.

CONTRACTOR shall comply with all local, state and federal statutes, ordinances, codes, rules, regulations and all case law pertaining to the provision of the GOODS to a public body, including but not limited to all of the applicable provisions of the Illinois Human Rights Act (775 ILCS 5/1-01 *et seq.*)

CONTRACTOR will not be relieved of any obligation to the VILLAGE in performance of the Contract due to failure to examine or receive documents, visit or become familiar with conditions under which the GOODS shall be used or from facts of which CONTRACTOR should have been aware and VILLAGE shall consider all incidents of nonperformance of the Contract related thereto as incidents of default and a breach of the Contract.

The VILLAGE is a public body and is exempt from excise, sales and use taxes; therefore, CONTRACTOR shall not include any such taxes in its cost figures.

The VILLAGE shall have the right to inspect the GOODS and test the GOODS for suitability for use before acceptance. The CONTRACTOR shall be responsible for the contracted quality and standards of all GOODS supplied under this contract up to the time of final acceptance by the VILLAGE. GOODS not complying with the requirements of the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS may be rejected by the VILLAGE and upon rejection shall be removed at no cost to the Village.

All guarantees and warranties required shall be furnished by the CONTRACTOR and shall be delivered to the VILLAGE before final voucher on the contract is issued.

Execution of the Contract between VILLAGE and CONTRACTOR is contingent upon receipt of any certifications required by the VILLAGE.

The VILLAGE may, at any time, terminate the Contract for the VILLAGE'S convenience and without cause upon written notice to the CONTRACTOR.



Statement of Work

Village of Orlando Park, IL System i to System i Migration, with i5/OS upgrade Services

This Statement of Work ("SOW") is made by and between Sirius Computer Solutions, Inc., ("Sirius") and Village of Orlando Park, IL ("Customer") for the provision of certain professional services as more fully described herein, ("Services"). Customer and Sirius expressly acknowledge and agree that this SOW is incorporated by reference into, and made a part of, RFP dated October 8th, 2007 (the "Agreement"). In the event of conflict, the terms of the Agreement shall control unless otherwise expressly provided herein. Unless otherwise agreed, Sirius reserves the right to subcontract any or all portions of the Services contemplated hereunder.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Sirius will migrate your existing System i820 server, ("**source server**") running OS/400 release V5R1 to a new System i525 Server ("**target server**") running i5/OS V5R4M5 with a two trip engagement. The first trip will be to setup the target server and do the initial load of your libraries for testing purposes. The second trip will be to synchronize the target server with the source server and ready the target server for production. In addition, Sirius will also provide skills transfer on the new i5 server hardware.

1. Target server Installation, 1st Visit

- a. Pre-Installation/Configuration Planning
- b. Inventory all Hardware and Installed Software
- c. Perform initial configuration of HMC as console
- d. Update HMC code and Service Processor firmware (as necessary)
- e. Install target server hardware
- f. Remove IOP/IOA that connects the IBM 3580-001 tape drive and IBM 7208-342 tape drive to the 9406-820 and attach these devices to the new system.
- g. Install LIC, if applicable
- h. Verify/Assign Disk, configure RAID and set up ASP
- i. Load base i5/OS target server if necessary
- j. Configure Network Settings in a Side-by-Side configuration
- k. Provide administration skills transfer

2. Source server to target server Migration Services, 1st Visit

- a. Verify customer's media for migration
- b. Migrate system settings, user ids and configuration from source server to target server, as Slip
- c. Migrate User Data and Applications to target server, Slip to target server i5/OS
- d. Assist with configuration/testing of initial peripheral devices, (Printers and Workstations)
- e. Turn target server over to customer for full save and the start of testing

3. Source server to target server Cutover Services, 2nd Visit

- a. Planning for final cutover
- b. Verify customer's media backup
- c. Scratch install or refresh all User Data from source server to target server
- d. Migrate any hardware, all cables and peripheral connections
- e. Verify successful migration and normal operation
- f. Turn system over for production

RESPONSIBILITIES

Sirius Responsibilities

1. Document each task necessary to complete the Services and send a final report to Customer when such tasks are completed.
2. Staff this effort with appropriately skilled individuals to perform the Services.
3. Assign a Project Manager who will serve as the primary contact for Customer.
4. Promptly notify Customer of any unsafe condition about which Sirius has knowledge.

Statement of Work

Customer Responsibilities

1. Back-up all data, software, operating systems, software configurations and networking configurations in preparation for and during the performance of the Services. Sirius shall not be liable for any lost, damaged or corrupted data.
2. Have the appropriate software and hardware available at the beginning of the project and ensure that the necessary hardware environment (operating system, network, ports) is configured appropriately and is stable.
3. Provide Sirius with access to Customer's facilities and appropriate resources as reasonably necessary for Sirius to fulfill its obligations hereunder, including but not limited to: an adequate work area, network access, telephones, terminal, access to PC-based printer, remote access to systems (if applicable), and access to an outside telephone line that can be used for internet access.
4. Designate a specific authorized representative for making decisions relating to the Services, and provide knowledge resources as requested for information on internal systems, including but not limited to, network infrastructure. Customer's staff will participate throughout the implementation.
5. Perform pre and post media backups.
6. Verify that all third party software will run correctly on the target server.
7. Promptly notify Sirius of any unsafe condition about which Customer has knowledge and to which Sirius resources could be exposed.
8. Promptly notify Sirius of any accidents or injuries involving Sirius employees or subcontractors assigned to Customer.
9. Promptly inspect and accept Services and/or Deliverables upon completion by Sirius.

Joint Responsibilities

1. Sirius and Customer will work together to establish acceptance criteria.

DELIVERABLES

This SOW will produce the following specific deliverables and/or objectives ("Deliverables"). Costs contained in this SOW were created based on these Deliverables and objectives only. Tasks, deliverables and responsibilities not explicitly addressed within this SOW are beyond its scope and can only be provided pursuant to the change process described herein or pursuant to a separate SOW as mutually agreed to by both parties. Except as explicitly set forth in this SOW, Sirius shall have no obligation to provide maintenance or support services for Deliverables or to modify or remediate Deliverables in any manner following Customer's acceptance thereof.

1. Weekly status reports and/or completion report
2. Knowledge transfer

ASSUMPTIONS

Sirius has created this SOW under the following assumptions. If one or more of these assumptions proves to be invalid, costs and other project factors may be impacted.

1. Customer is responsible for pre and post media backups
2. Customer is responsible for making sure all applications are compatible with the Target Server i5/OS.
3. Customer is responsible for application testing.

SCHEDULE

Sirius and Customer will determine a schedule for work to be performed once execution of this SOW occurs. The schedule will include expected response times for Customer to review and complete tasks. Sirius will use commercially reasonable efforts to timely complete the Services.



Statement of Work

FEE SCHEDULE

Services Costs

The Services will be provided for a fixed price of \$7,000.00. Customer will be invoiced upon completion of the Services.

Travel Costs

If a local resource is used, travel costs will not be charged to Customer. If a non-local resource is needed, then Customer will be charged for reasonable out-of-pocket travel and living expenses. Upon request, Sirius will provide receipts for individual line item expenses valued at \$25.00 or greater.

ACCEPTANCE

Upon completion of the Services, Sirius will submit a Completion Document in a form set forth at Exhibit A. Customer will return the Completion Document in accordance with its instructions within three (3) business days from the date of receipt thereof. If Customer reasonably believes that Sirius failed to substantially complete the Services in accordance with this SOW, Customer will notify Sirius in writing of its reasons for rejection of the Services or any portion thereof within three (3) business days from Customer's receipt of the Completion Document. If Sirius does not receive the signed Completion Document or written notification of the reasons for rejection within three (3) business days of Customer's receipt thereof, the absence of Customer's response will constitute Customer's acceptance of the Services and a waiver of any right of rejection.

CHANGE REQUESTS

From time to time Customer may request, or Sirius may propose, that Sirius implement a change to the Services reflected in this SOW including, without limitation, (a) a change to the scope of Services, or (b) a change in the prioritization or manner in which Sirius is performing the Services (each, a "Change"). In the event of the occurrence of a mutually agreed Change, Sirius shall prepare and provide to Customer a proposed change order. Sirius shall include in the proposed change order the effect, if any, the Change will have on Sirius' schedule of delivery of the Services, and if there will be any effect on the estimated cost or other Customer payments. Sirius shall not be responsible or liable for any delays, costs or damages resulting from Customer's rejection of, or delay in approving, a proposed change order relating to a Change.
