



Renovation and Site Improvements





The McGuane Park Fieldhouse Renovation project consisted of interior and exterior improvements of an existing 2-story park district fieldhouse.

The project featured a full interior renovation of the building lobby and rotunda portion, a new elevator addition, interior renovation of the second floor and minor interior finishes and equipment changes in the gymnasium and swimming pool areas.

New lighting and MEP systems were installed including a new roof top unit for the 2nd floor and new switch-gear for the building.

Exterior and site work included exterior door and curtain wall systems, a new elevator structure, entryway canopies at the main lobby, parking lot underground utilities and resurfacing, trash enclosure, spray pool feature area, concrete walkways and landscaping.

The new elevator structure was constructed of coldformed metal framing and rainscreen panels. The main library and rotunda area features new large, round light fixtures over solid surface bench seating.

The new steel canopies at the main lobby entrances are filled with illuminated, colored glass that dazzle in the evenings.

Sollitt was awarded the new Belmont-Cragin Elementary School and Early Childhood Center project located at 6112 W. Fullerton Ave., Chicago, IL. This project consisted of renovating and constructing an 83,0000sf, three-story, steel frame and masonry CPS L-shaped prototype design to serve a diverse community of 500+ Pre-K through 8th grade students.

The school sits at the southeastern corner of Riis Park. Uniquely, the school connects to the existing, historical Riis Park Fieldhouse so the school and Park District can jointly use the gymnasium and provide shared space for after-school activity use for the school and Park District functions.

Belmont Cragin has two wings, they comprise of general classrooms and naturally lit library space with day-lighting controls, custom built-in seating and quiet reading spaces, cafetorium, gymnasium and a state-of-the-art state & rigging system for assemblies, plays and afte school activities. There are specialty classrooms that focus on early education, STEM, science, art, music, choir and special education.


