In some years individual directors may have been eligible for market adjustments in addition to the COLA, these positions are not in a step increase structure.

Non-executive positions are in a step increase structure and are eligible for up to 5% increases between steps, in addition to the COLA.

**The 3.75% negotiated increases for IBEW and IUOE were deferred by agreement to January 1, 2011

Budgetary Concessions -

DCC - 5 furlough days in 2010

Executive - Required to take 5 furlough days or purchase 6 days in 2010. No salary increase in 2010.

IBEW - Deferred salary increase from 5/1/2010 1/1/2011. Each member of the bargaining group took 5 furlough days or purchased 6 vacation days.

IUOE - Deferred salary increase from 5/1/2010 to 1/1/2011. Each member of the bargaining group took 5 furlough days or purchased 6 vacation days.

Non-Union - No salary increase in 2010. Each employee took 5 furlough days or purchased 6 vacation days. Two non-union positions were eliminated and those employees were laid off.

No concessions agreed to by MAP, Police Supervisors, or AFSCME.
