2010-0585 LED Light Bars for New Police Vehicles - Purchase

Police Chief Timothy McCarthy reported that the Police Department is requesting to purchase seven (7) Federal Signal Legend LED Light Bars to be installed on police vehicles. The Legend light bar features new LED reflector technology for a bright off-axis light output for 360-degree coverage and draws less energy from the vehicle's electrical system. The Police Department would like to purchase the light bars from the FY2010 budget line item #010-7002-421.60-45 Equipment. The cost of each light bar is \$1,250.00 each. The total cost of the purchase of seven (7) Federal Signal Legend LED Light Bars would be \$8,750.00.
