AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING DONATION OF PERSONAL PROPERTY (BALLISTIC BLOCKS) OWNED BY THE VILLAGE OF ORLAND PARK, ILLINOIS, TO THE VILLAGE OF MATTESON POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Orland Park, Cook and Will Counties, Illinois ("Village") have determined that it is no longer necessary or useful for the Village of Orland Park to retain ownership of the personal property (ballistic blocks) described below; and

WHEREAS, the Village has therefore decided that continued ownership of the ballistic blocks described below is not in the best interests of the Village of Orland Park; and

WHEREAS, the ballistic blocks listed below are Village-owned property that have exhausted their usable life as ballistic blocks and are now obsolete for Village purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Matteson Police Department has need for the ballistic blocks to support the many programs offered by the organization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Orland Park, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1

The above recitals are hereby incorporated into this section as fully as if they were set forth herein in their entirety.

SECTION 2

Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Orland Park find that the item of personal property listed on <u>EXHIBIT A</u> (ballistic blocks) now owned by the Village of Orland Park, Illinois, is no longer necessary or useful to the Village and its best interests and the interests of the residents of the Orland Park will be best served by the donation of such ballistic blocks to the Village of Matteson Police Department as described above.

SECTION 3

The Village Manager is hereby authorized to and may direct the donation to the Village of Matteson Police Department of the ballistic blocks to which Section 2 of this Ordinance refers.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, by a vote of at least a simple majority of the Corporate Authorities, in the manner provided by law.
