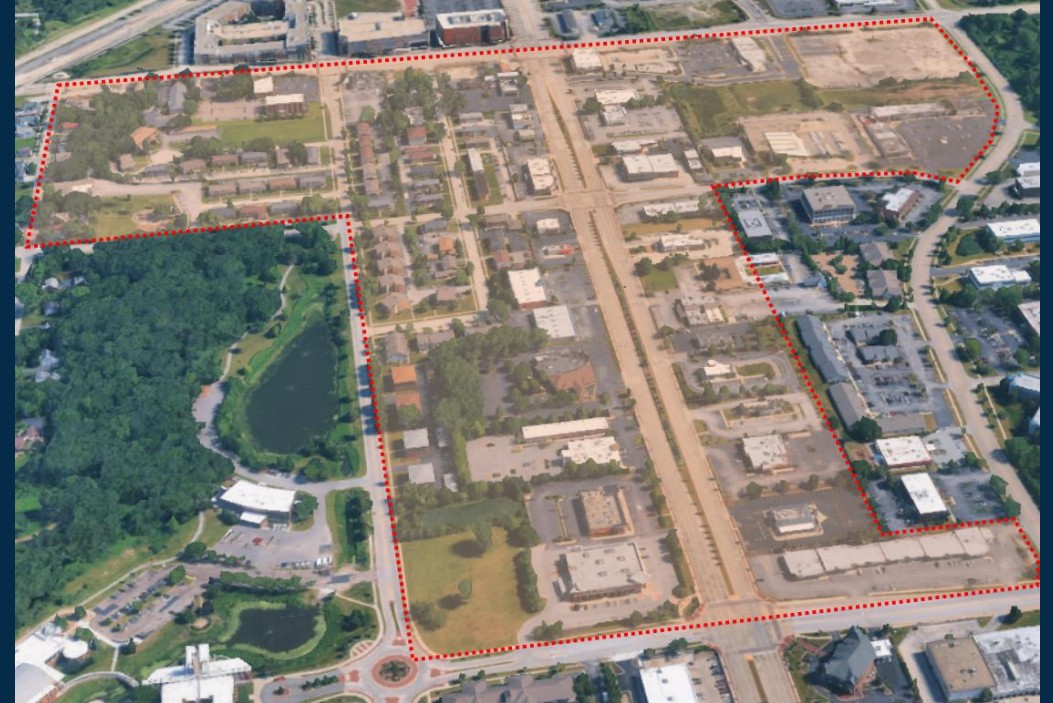

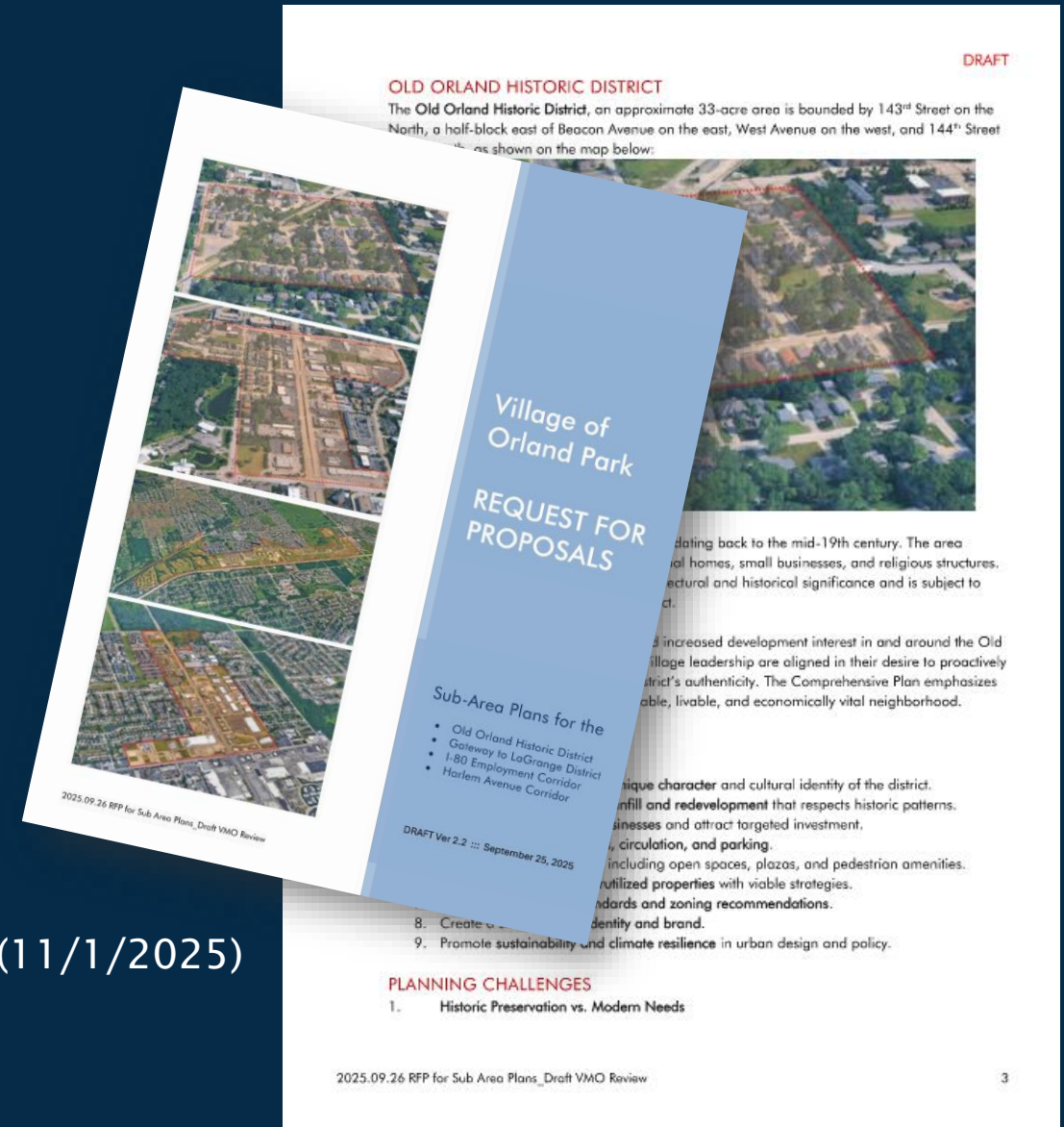

BACKGROUND

- 9-month hold on certain land uses
- Acceptance and approval of new business license, development, and zoning applications after the date of this ordinance
- Does not apply to licensed existing business
- Prevent the overdevelopment of certain specific types of businesses, protect the viability of the current businesses in the Village, and reduce the potential for unstable commercial turnover



AFFECTED LAND USES

- Repossession Lot
- Scrap or Junk Yard
- Retail Mattress Businesses
- Pawn Shops, Secondhand Stores, or Flea Markets
- Unlicensed Day Labor Center
- Temporary Employment or Placement Agency
- Coffee and/or Tea Shop
- Breakfast Restaurant
- Alternative Financial Services: e.g. currency exchange, check cashing, money transfers, or short-term high interest lending
- Grocery Stores not exceeding 50,000 square feet of floor area
- Standalone convenience store
- Jewelry Store
- Personal grooming establishment
- Lodging Establishment
