INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR SHARED PARKING

This INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR SHARED PARKING ("Agreement") is entered into and effective _____, 2010, by and between the **Orland Fire Protection District**, Cook County, Illinois, an Illinois Fire District, and the **Village of Orland Park**, Cook and Will Counties, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation.

RECITALS

A. WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 6-306F of the Land Development Code, the Village of Orland Park, Illinois, specifies criteria which must be met in order to utilize off-site shared parking agreements to satisfy on-site parking requirements.

B. WHEREAS, the Orland Fire Protection District is preparing for an expansion and remodeling construction project which requires it to utilize off-site shared parking agreements to satisfy on-site parking requirements;

C. WHEREAS, the Village of Orland Park Police Department is located approximately one block away from the Orland Fire Protection District and is willing to enter into a shared parking agreement with the Orland Fire Protection District.

D. WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois authorizes units of local government, including fire protection districts and municipal corporations, to cooperate with each other in order to accomplish common goals and objectives, and to contract to exercise, combine or transfer any power of function not prohibited to them by law or ordinance; and

E. WHEREAS, the Illinois Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/1, et seq.) authorizes units of local government, including fire protection districts and municipal corporations, to exercise jointly with any public agency of the State, including other units of local government, any power, privilege or authority which may be exercised by a unit of local government individually, and to enter into contracts for the performance of governmental services, activities and undertakings;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the recitals and mutual obligations of the parties as herein expressed, the Orland Fire Protection District and the Village of Orland Park agree as follows:

1. The Village of Orland Park, the owner of the property located at 15100 S. Ravinia Avenue, Orland Park, Illinois 60462, agrees to provide the Orland Fire Protection District, the owner of the property located at 9788 W. 151st Street, Orland Park, Illinois 60462, with the right to the use of twenty-four (24) parking spaces Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. on property located at 15100 S. Ravinia Avenue, Orland Park, Illinois 60462, as legally described below.

1.1 Applicant: Orland Fire Protection District

Parcel 1:

Legal Description: The West 200 feet of the South 250 feet of the West half of the East half of the Southeast quarter of Section 9, Township 36 North, Range 12 East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

1.2 Party Supplying Parking: Village of Orland Park

Legal Description: The South 719.0 feet of the North 759 feet of the West 567 feet of the East 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 16, Township 36 North, Range 12, East of the Third Principal Meridian, in Cook County, Illinois.

2. The parking spaces referred to in this Agreement have been determined to conform to current Village of Orland Park standards for parking spaces, and the Parties agree to maintain the parking spaces to meet those standards.

3. The Parties understand and agree that if for any reason the off-site parking spaces are no longer available for use by the Orland Fire Protection District, the Orland Fire Protection District will be in violation of the Village of Orland Park Land Development Code requirements. If the off-site parking spaces are no longer available, Applicant will be required to reduce or cease operation and use of the property at Applicant's address to an intensity approved by the
