

Orland Park Area Chamber of Commerce
2024 Summerfest Safety Plan

Recommendations are based upon established staffing and security procedures enacted at the previous Orland Days Celebrations and those that are currently in place for the Taste of Orland Park.

Controlled Access to the Grounds: Similar to the Taste of Orland Park and the Summer Concert Series in the past, fencing needs to be erected around the site. This fencing will allow access points to be controlled to the grounds. These access points will have metal detectors (the purpose of these detectors is to check for weapons on a person, which are not detected during a bag check) and will need to be staffed by non-police, trained security personnel to include bag checks. A signed agreement from a security company will need to be provided.

Signage: Signs will need to be posted at all entrances with items that are prohibited from being brought into the grounds.

Officer Staffing: 5 Officers and 1 Supervisor—per day

Additional personnel may be added based on needs

Beer Tent Fencing: The entire event will be fenced and ages will be checked upon entrance with those over 21 given a wristband; No other areas will be fenced.

Traffic Concerns/Staffing: Recommendation of (7) CSO on site from open to close. No recommendation of street closures.

-3 at the Metra entrance on 153rd Street.

-2 at Park Station Blvd.

-2 at the Centennial West parking lot

*** No recommendation of street closures.
