2014-0407 Pool Pump Repair for Centennial Park Aquatic Center

Director Stec reported that in emergency repair for a pump in the zero depth pool was needed due to corrosion in the shaft area. This pump was repaired by Thomas Pump in a very short time frame to keep this area operational. Thomas was selected as they had to pump repair parts on-hand and were able to respond immediately to complete the repair.

2014-0406 Sportsplex HVAC Repair

Director Stec reported that the Building Maintenance division made emergency repairs to two of the HVAC units at the Sportsplex. One was in the large gym and the other in the soccer field area. Both compressors failed and have been replaced. Parts were purchased from Thermosystems Aftermarket Division in Elmhurst at a cost of \$14,482.72. After repairing the soccer field unit, the second compressor on the unit also failed (making 3 compressors total repaired). This unit was purchased from G.W. Berkheimer Co. as they had this part in stock, at a cost of \$5,703.33. To perform the work, a crane was needed to lift the units at a cost of \$2,550.00.

File Name: Approve Increase to Classic Party Rentals Contract for 2014 Taste of Orland Park

BACKGROUND:

A three year contract with Classic Party Rentals to provide tents and equipment for the Taste of Orland Park event in 2013, 2014, and 2015 was approved by the Board of Trustees on May 20, 2013.

The 2014 amount was set at \$15,591.20. Following the approval, on-site sponsors increased from twelve, which was the number in 2013, to seventeen in 2014 and a new restaurant was included in this year's Taste event, for an increase in revenue of \$7,100. Tents, tables, chairs, and tent lights are individually priced depending on the number needed. The additional cost to provide tents and equipment for five new sponsors, one new restaurant, and a tent to cover the ATM machine is \$392.87 over the contracted price of \$15,591.50 for a total 2014 invoice of \$15,984.37.

BUDGET IMPACT:

Funds have been allocated in the 2014 Taste of Orland Park budget.

WHEREAS, the Village of Orland Park is the owner of personal property (27" Admiral Television) that has exhausted its usable life and is obsolete; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities of the Village of Orland Park, Cook and Will Counties, Illinois, have decided that it is no longer necessary or useful for the Village of Orland Park to retain ownership of said personal property; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have, therefore, decided that continued ownership of the 27" Admiral Television is not in the best interests of the Village of Orland Park; and

WHEREAS, the Special Recreation Department of the Village of Orland Park would like to donate said personal property to the November 1, 2014 Special Recreation Garage Sale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Orland Park, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1

The above recitals are hereby incorporated into this Section as fully as if they were set forth herein in their entirety.

SECTION 2

Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code, Illinois Compiled Statutes, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Orland Park find that the 27" Admiral Television now owned by the Village of Orland Park, Illinois, is no longer necessary or useful to the said Village and its best interests will be served by the disposal of said personal property by the Village Manager.

SECTION 3

Pursuant to the said Section 11-76-4, the Village Manager is hereby authorized to and may direct the disposal of the personal property to which Section 2 of this Ordinance refers by donating said personal property to the November 1, 2014 Special Recreation Garage Sale free of charge. The 27" Admiral Television is to be disposed of "AS-IS" without warranties of any kind. In particular, the Village of Orland Park makes no warranties or representations expressed or implied about the performance ability of the television, about its present state of repair, about its condition or maintenance, or its merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.

SECTION 4

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, by a vote of at least a simple majority of the Corporate Authorities, and approval in the manner provided by law.
