AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 8, CHAPTER 2, OF THE ORLAND PARK VILLAGE CODE REGARDING PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS

WHEREAS, the Village of Orland Park, Cook and Will Counties, Illinois (the “Village”) is an Illinois home rule municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village have the statutory and home rule authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and to protect the public health, safety and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the public to provide for the minimum qualifications required of part-time police officers hired by the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Orland Park, Cook and Will Counties, Illinois, pursuant to the Village’s home rule powers, as follows:

SECTION 1:

The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2:

Title 8, Chapter 1, is amended by Section 8-1-14 deleting in its entirety the text of said Section 8-1-14 and to substitute the following as the new text of said Section:

“8-1-14: PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS:

**Appointment:** There is hereby established the position of part-time officer. Part-time police officers shall have the duties assigned to them as prescribed by the Chief of Police or his or her designee. The number of part-time police officers shall be as determined by the corporate authorities of the Village.

**Qualifications:** The minimum qualifications of a part-time police officer are as follows:

- a. Must have attained the age of twenty-one (21) years upon submission of the application for employment;
- b. Must be trained in accordance with the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/1, et seq.) and in accordance with the rules and requirements of the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board; and

c. Must complete a forty (40) hour mandatory accredited firearms training course.”

**SECTION 3:**

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as provided by law.
